### **Risk Assessment**

Improving quality and consistency, strengthening the linkage with planning and decision making



Defining risk appetite internally with appropriate metrics for countries, regions and functions



Better visibility and use of risk information – Risk System – and building risk management capability in the field

### **Progress to date**

- Rollout of new Risk Categorization
- Regional Bureaux (RBx)/Deputy Country Director training for 2019 process
- Direct Support to L2/L3 and Country Offices submitting Country Strategic Plans (CSPs)

### **Next steps**

- Continue to build consistency and quality with Country Office (CO) Risk Assessments
- Support major functions with end to end process risk assessments
- Risk assessments for new initiatives and change programmes
- Consistency of mitigation plans: Corporate/Functions/RBx/COs

## **Risk Reporting**


### **Progress to date**

- Pilot HQ risk appetite report shared with EMG and Audit Committee
- High Risk countries being prioritized for CO risk appetite reporting
- Indicator library being compiled for RBx and COs

### Next steps

- Continue to develop/refine HQ risk appetite report
- Go live in higher risk countries with meaningful appetite reporting
- Support functions with process level metrics/reporting
- Consistency of issue and recommendation tracking processes

Allocation: USD 1,853 K


## **Strengthening CBT** data management

  - Continued investment in leadership and functional learning

## Strengthened Enterprise Risk Management and Internal Controls

- Risk and Recommendation tracking tool under development
- Augmented RCA support in high risk operations

Allocation: USD 534 K

Strengthening guidance & internal controls in Management Services/Administration to improve fraud prevention & risk management in COs

- Comprehensive Management and Administrative Services Manual developed
- 2019 global roll-out and training

Allocation: USD 500 K


## HQ & RB scoping review/ optimization support

### AFAC Strategy & Action Plan, 2018-2020



### **Build awareness & benchmarking (Aug 18 – May 19)**

- Train colleagues in high risk areas
- Gather feedback on risks, gaps and priority needs
- Take stock and benchmark against best practice

#### Enhance policy, tools & build capacity (Jun 19 – Feb 20)

- Update AFAC and related policies
- Develop tools and guidance required to implement
- Build Regional Bureau capacity

### **Embed AFAC standards (Mar – July 20)**

- Equip WFP global workforce with practical fraud management skills
- Reporting metrics, indicators, alerts, dashboard, etc.

### **Training & Feedback Missions**


- Nigeria, South Sudan, Somalia, Afghanistan COs
