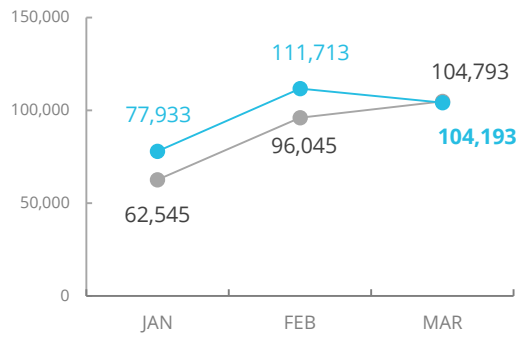
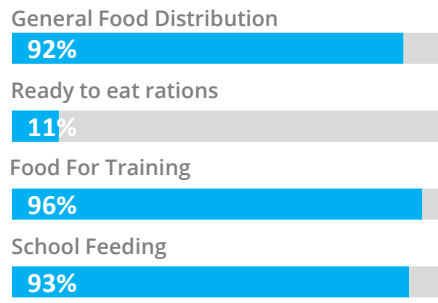

  - ✘ Food for training activities on hold due to curfews and movement restrictions (imposed second half of the March)
  - ✔ Take-home rations for children and their families provided from 30 March

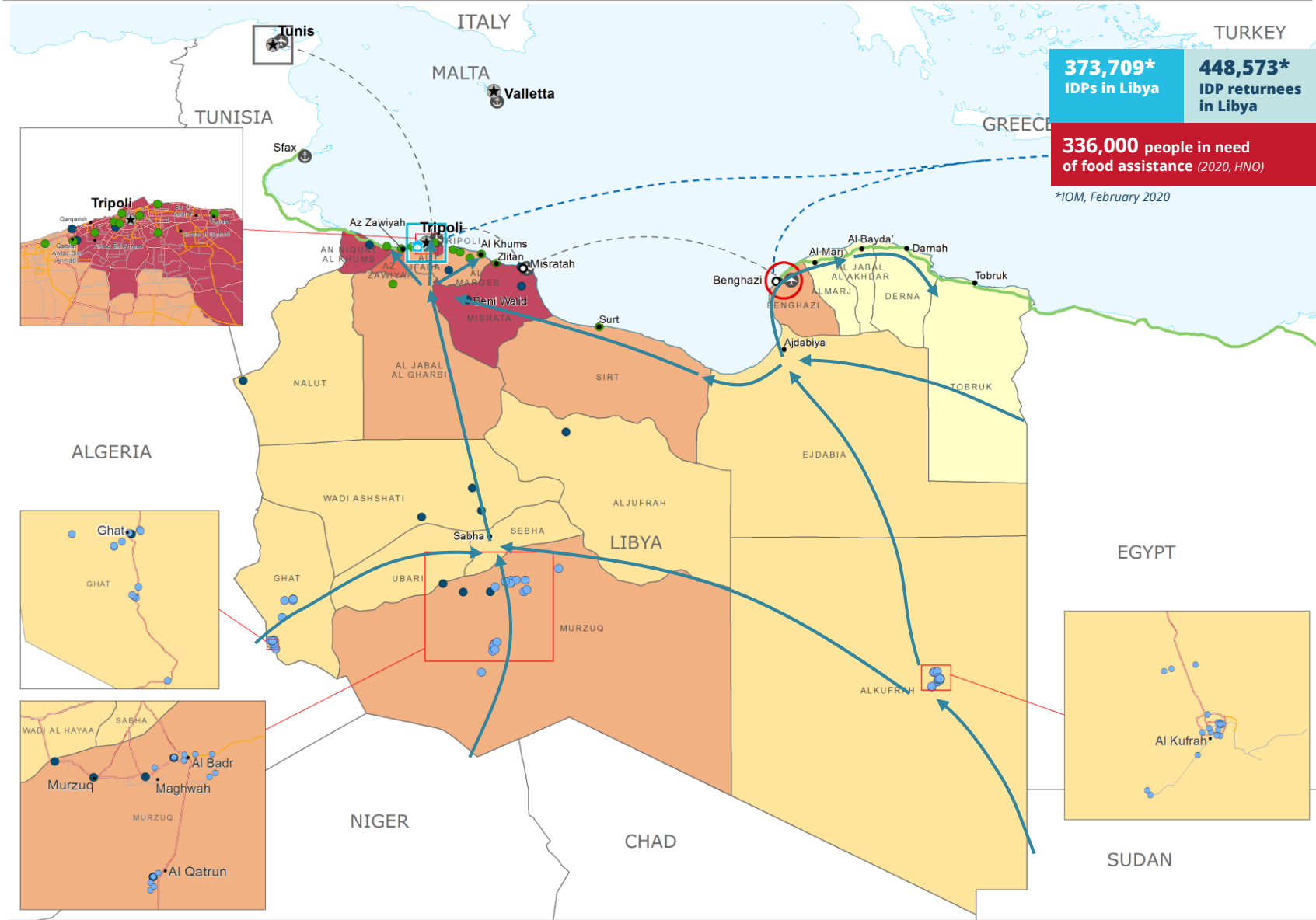

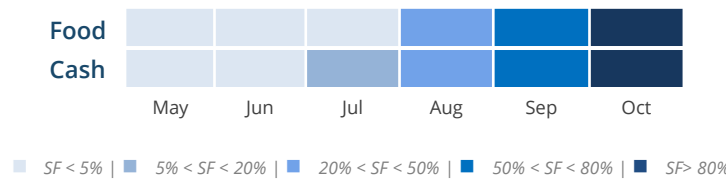

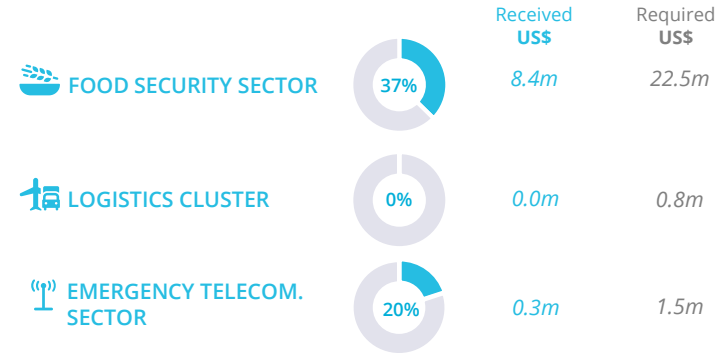
## AVERAGE MONTHLY FUNDING REQUIREMENTS (US\$)



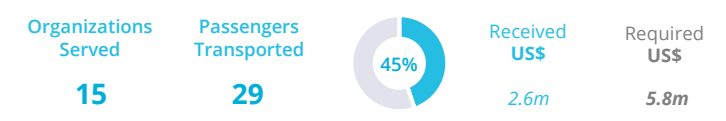
## EXPECTED SHORTFALLS
