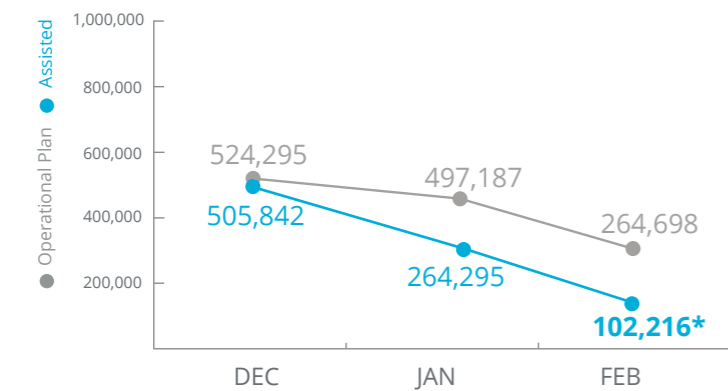

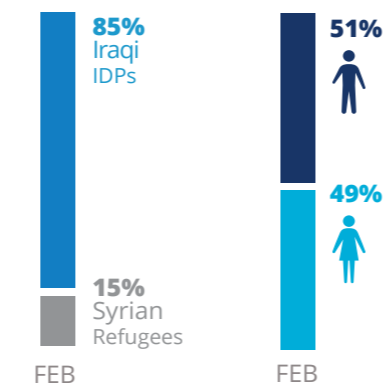

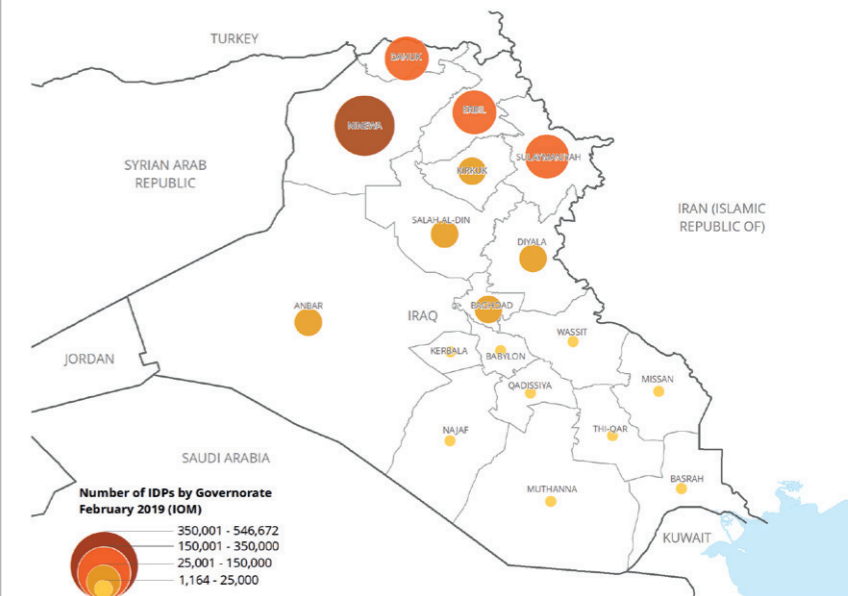

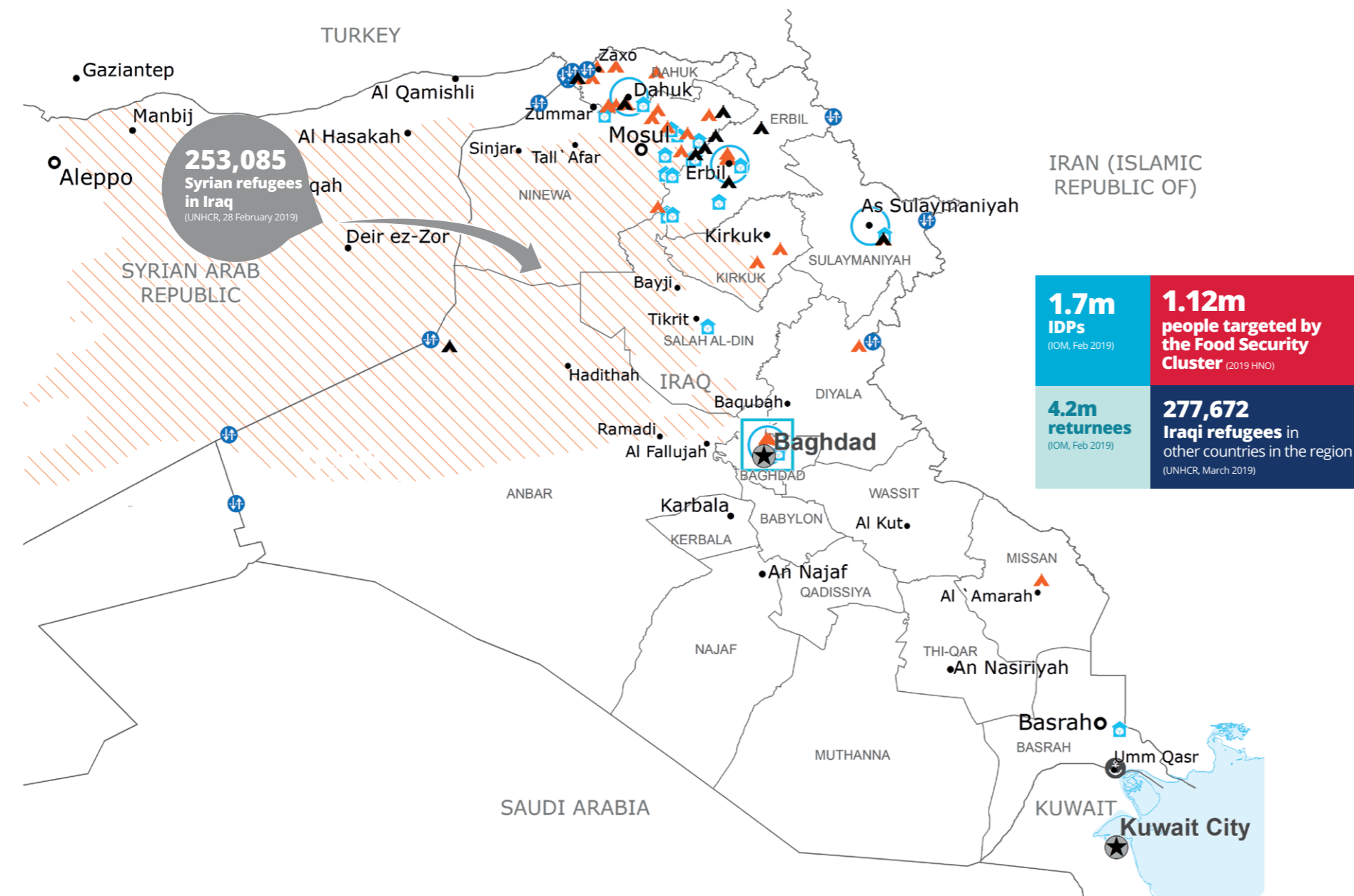

AS OF FEBRUARY 2019



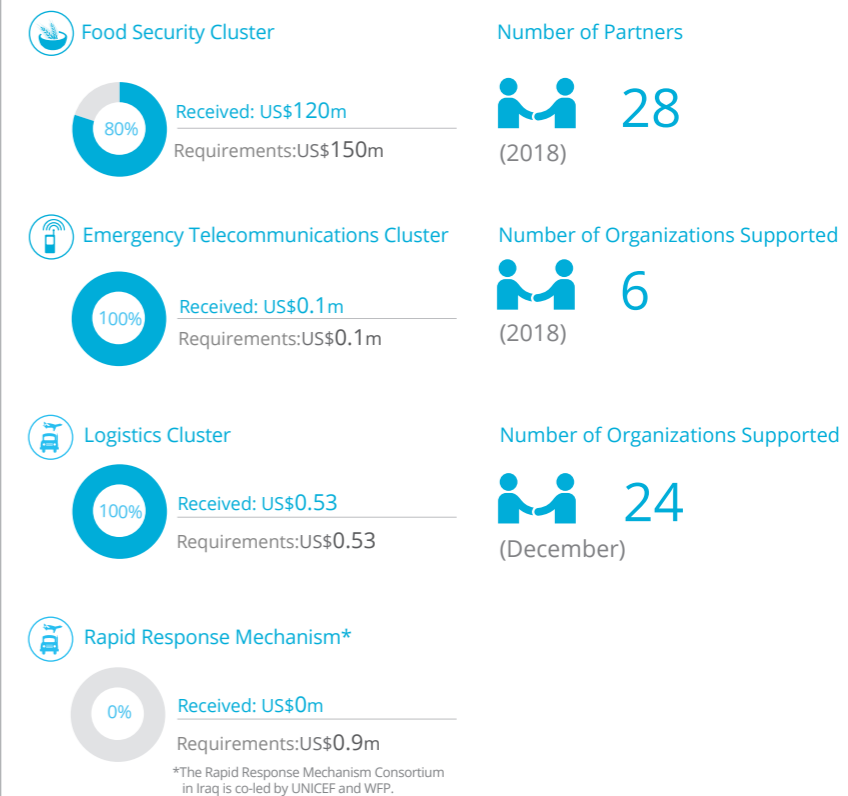
