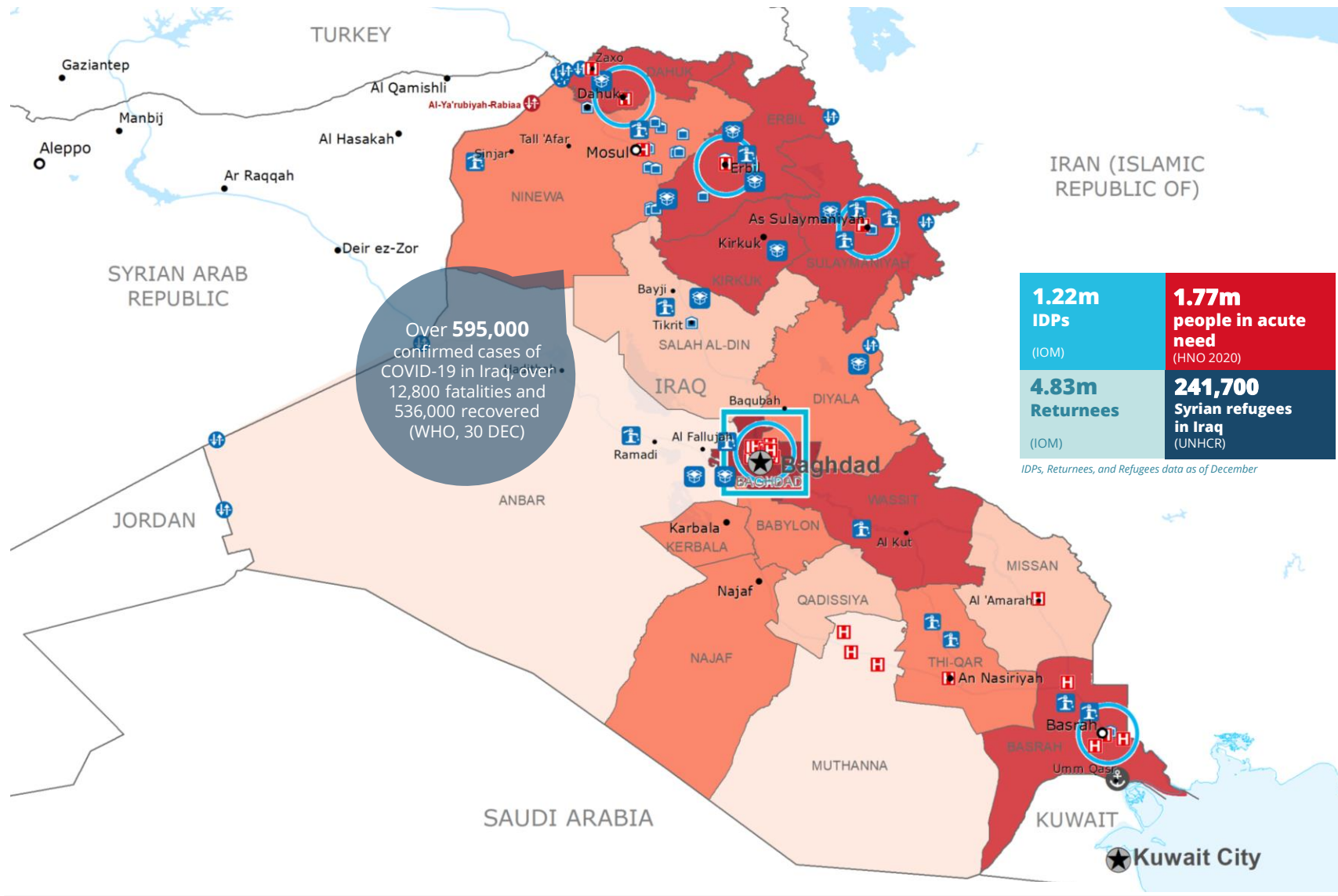
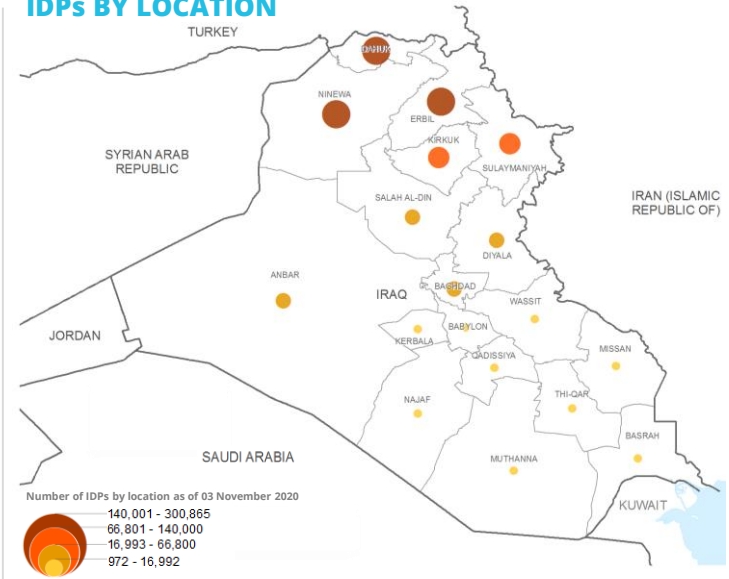

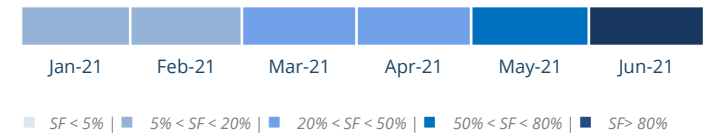

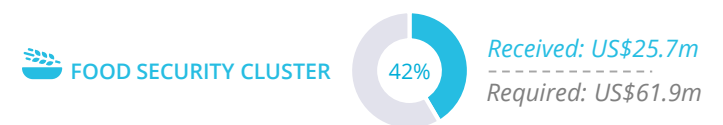
AVERAGE MONTHLY FUNDING REQUIREMENTS (6 Months -US\$)
