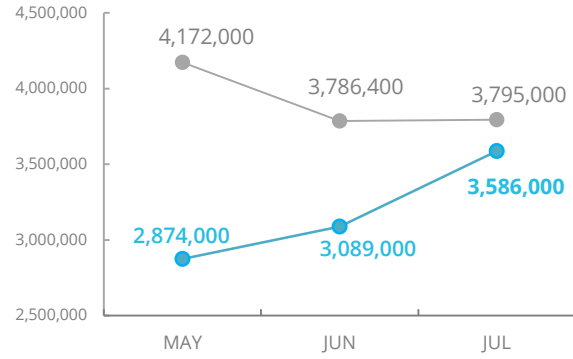

- ✔ School feeding activities (100%)

MALI

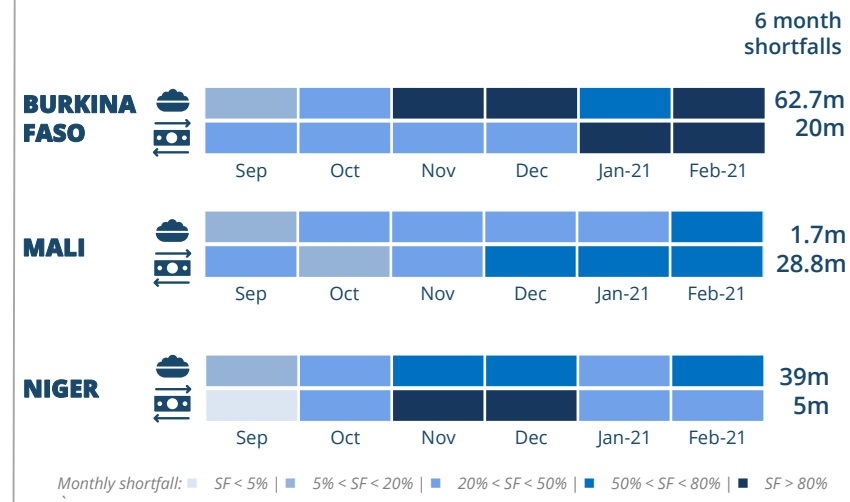
- ✔ GFA: Mitigation measures in place (100%)
- ✔ Nutrition: Mitigation measures in place (100%)
- ✔ Food for Assets: Replacing community-based activities with individual household activities (64%)
- ➔ School feeding activities: rations ongoing covering July and August (N/A)

NIGER

- ✔ GFA: Mitigation measures in place (96%)
- ✔ Nutrition: Mitigation measures in place (100%)
- ✔ Food for Assets (FFA) (100%)
- ➔ School feeding activities: take home rations (100%)

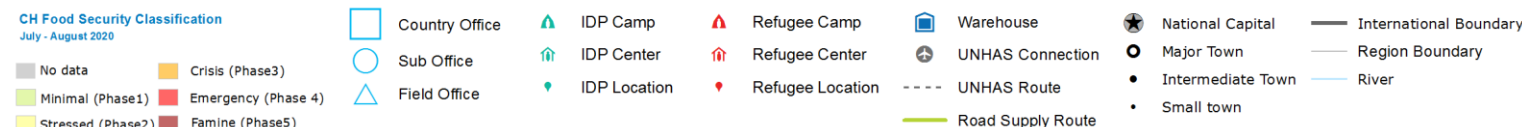
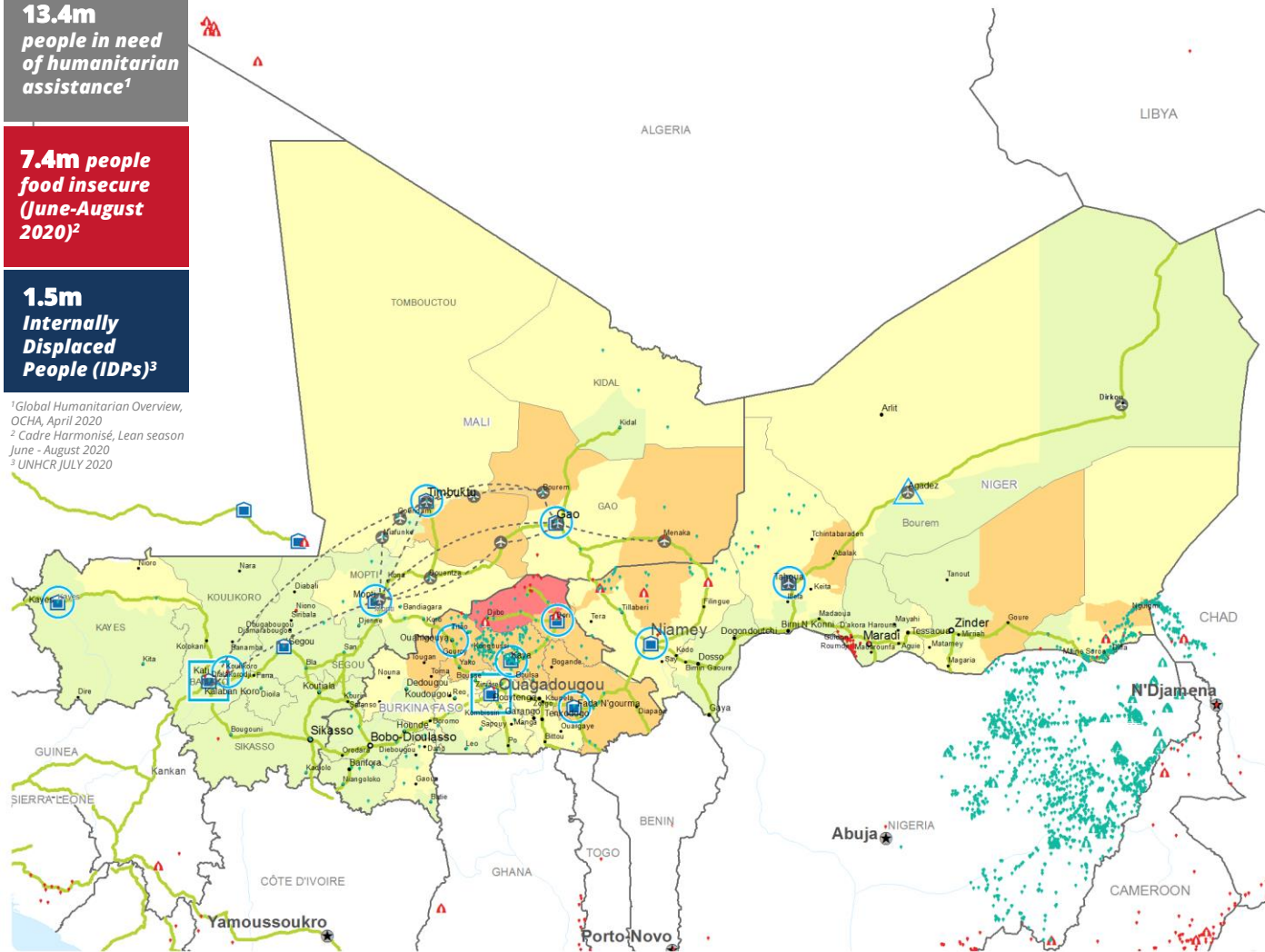

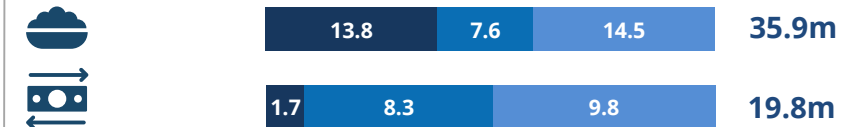

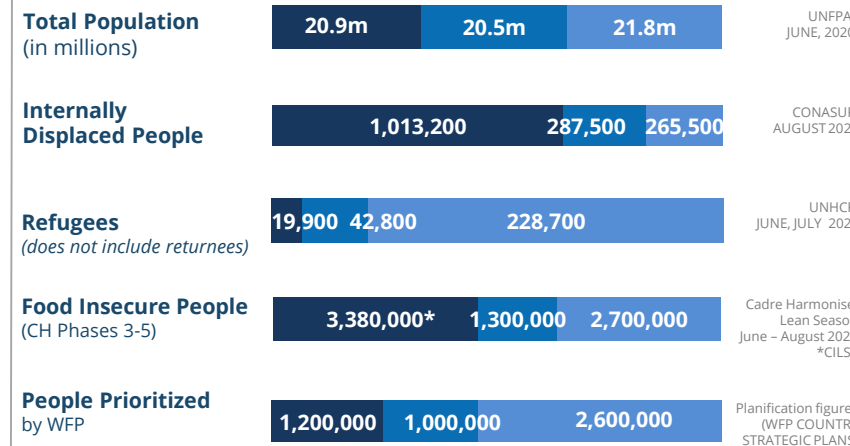
