Denmark and the United States of America are pleased to invite you to a side event on the presentation of the findings of MOPAN assessment of the World Food Programme (2016–2018) (released in February 2019).

The Multilateral Organisation Performance Assessment Network (MOPAN) is a network of 18 donor countries that jointly assess the performance of multilateral organisations. Members of MOPAN use the outcomes of these assessments to inform both strategic decision-making as well as engagement with the assessed organizations. The assessments also give the organizations a useful external view on their performance and relevance.

The MOPAN assessment of WFP covers the period 2016 to mid-2018. It involved a document review, an online partner survey conducted in 11 countries,² and interviews and consultations with WFP staff.

Denmark and the United States of America are serving as the lead countries for this assessment. The role of institutional lead is to ensure the assessment is fair, accurate and credible, and to present the findings to WFP. The launch of this report will also be an opportunity for MOPAN members and other member states to discuss the key findings.
