

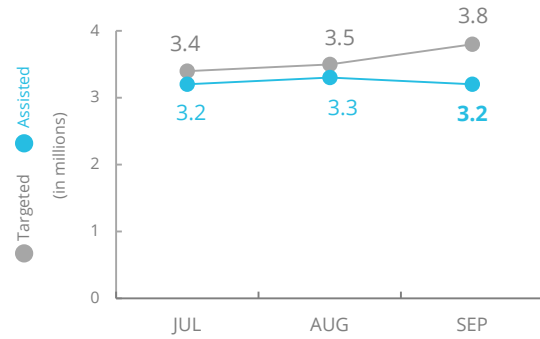

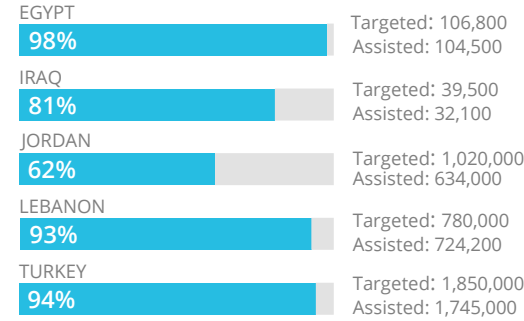

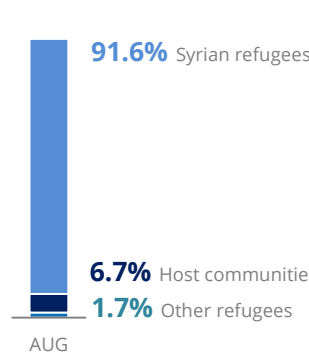
ASSISTANCE BREAKDOWN* By Country (September)

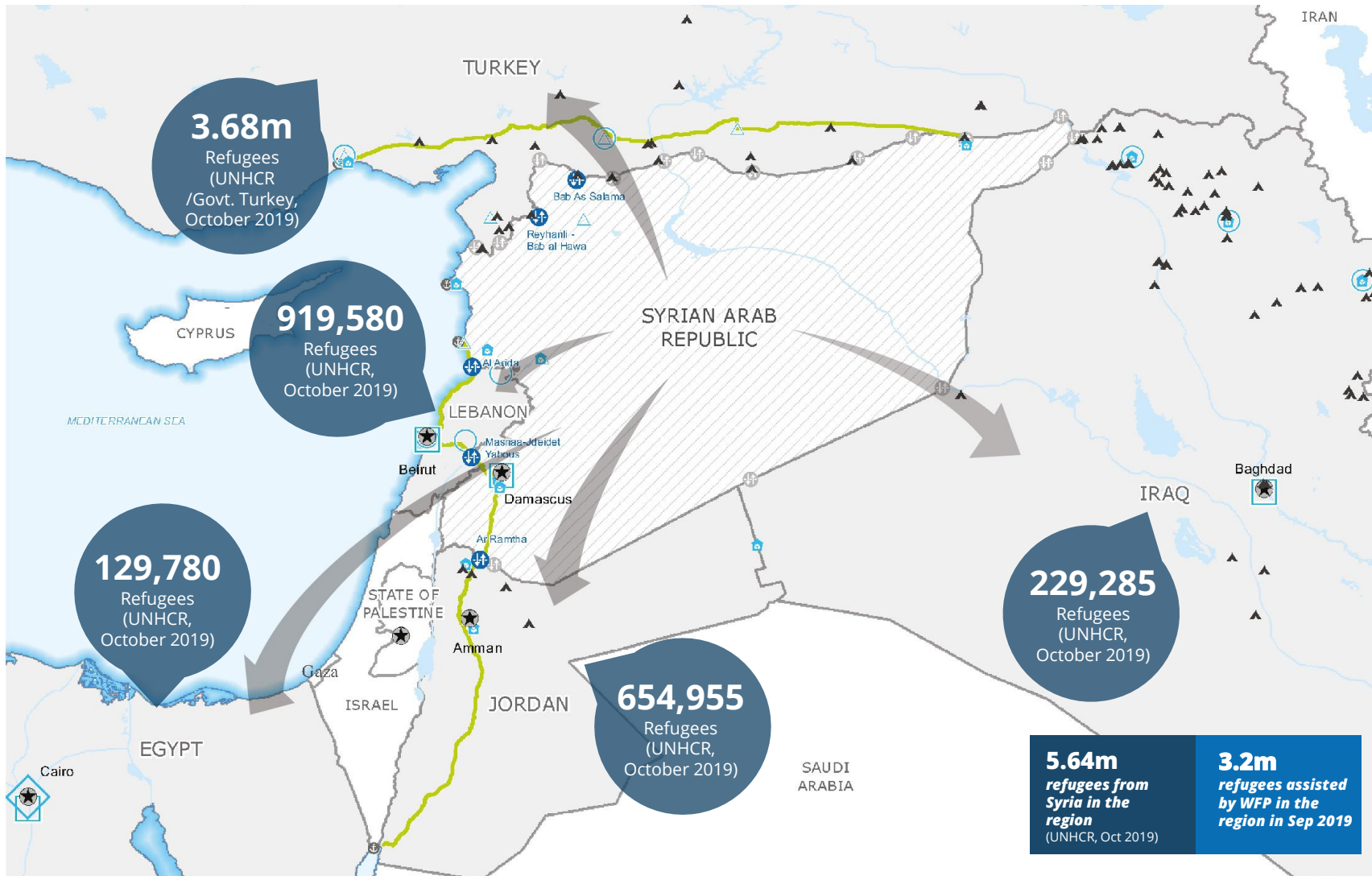

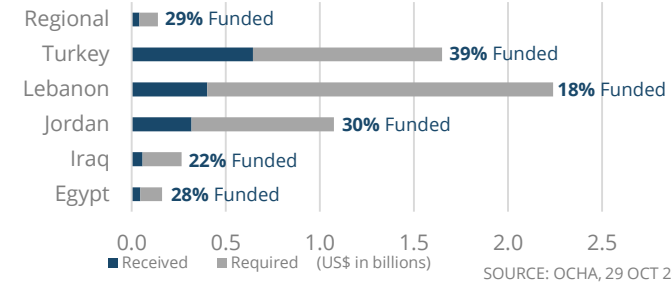
