



Evaluation by type, 2013




PART 1: Findings

Confirmation

- **Relevance** and **effectiveness** of WFP's emergency response
- Application of food assistance to **longer term needs**
- **FFA/T** effective for land-based productivity, gendered livelihoods support and social cohesion
- Increased efforts towards flexible and **locally responsive** programming
- Gender-sensitive country based programming
- Pilots to develop **innovative** programming

Challenges

- Rigidities of **in-kind** humanitarian funding and programme categories
- Chronic **under-funding** of longer term perspective programming



Conclusions

- Need for longer term **strategic positioning** with partners supported by **funding diversification**
- Country portfolios need more systematic & longer term strategic planning
- WFP's work is relevant in **MICS** but **operating models** not conducive to long term engagement required
- Scope for **common services** and more **technical guidance**/support in small COs
- Stronger **M&E** systems alongside other analysis/assessments.

Recommendations

1 Set clear and systematic requirements for CO Strategic Planning


2 Define (*and meet*) essential capacity requirements for small CO's
