The UN General Assembly and the FAO Conference (in resolution 53/223 of 23 April 1999 and 6/99 of 13 November 1999 respectively) approved the distribution of seats at the WFP Executive Board with effect from 1 January 2000 and requested that it be reviewed two years before the end of one full rotation scheme of four terms.

Such review shall be in accordance with the relevant provisions of General Assembly resolutions 48/162 and 50/8, taking into account the relevant inputs of the ECOSOC and the FAO Council; the results of the review shall enter into force on 1 January 2012.

(2) New Zealand was elected for the term 2007/2008/2009. New Zealand resigned in favour of Belgium effective 31 December 2007 and for the remainder of the term (i.e. for 2008, 2009).
