(1) Algeria was elected for the term 2006/2007/2008. Algeria resigned in favour of Sudan for the year 2007 and retrieved the seat effective 1 January 2008 and for the remainder of the term (i.e. for 2008).

(2) The rotating seat is occupied by a country of List A for 2000/2001/2002, List B for 2003/2004/2005, List A for 2006/2007/2008 and List C for 2009/2010/2011. After this a new pattern should be agreed among the Member States.

(3) New Zealand was elected for the term 2007/2008/2009. New Zealand resigned in favour of Belgium effective 31 December 2007 and for the remainder of the term (i.e. for 2008, 2009).

(4) Switzerland was elected for the term 2006/2007/2008. Switzerland resigned in favour of Finland effective 31 December 2007 and for the remainder of the term (i.e. for 2008).

(5) Austria was elected for the term 2006/2007/2008. Austria resigned in favour of Italy effective 31 December 2007 and for the remainder of the term (i.e. for 2008).
