

## ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY:

In June 2018, WFP Afghanistan conducted a baseline market monitoring and mapping survey using mVAM in 9 of the most drought-affected provinces in Northern region of Afghanistan; Badghis, Faryab, Saripul, Jawzjan, Balkh, Takhar, Ghor, Kunduz, and Badakhshan. In September 2018, a second round of data collection took place in order to see the food prices and the overall variation in the prices compared to last 3 months. Two call operators based in the WFP Country Office carried out a total number of 250 key informant interviews, mainly with traders and Shura leaders in the target provinces.

## Key Findings:

- The average retail prices of the staple food (rice, wheat grain, wheat flour, and cooking oil) in Badghis, Ghor, Kunduz, Faryab, Jawzjan, Balkh and Takhar provinces **remain the same** compared to July 2018.
  - The average retail prices of these staple foods have **increased** only in Badakhshan province and have **decreased** in Saripul province compared to last 3 months.

## Food Prices:

In Badghis, Ghor, Kunduz, Faryab, Jawzjan, Balkh and Takhar provinces the average retail prices of staple foods (rice, wheat grain, wheat flour, and cooking oil) remain the same compared to 3 months ago. The average retail prices of these staple foods have increased only in Badakhshan province over the last 3 months. The main reason for the increase in prices is decreased availability of the staple foods and limited supply to the markets during September 2018. The average retail prices of staple foods (Rice, wheat grain, wheat flour, cooking oil) have only decreased in Saripul province compared to last 3 months. Main reason for the decrease was increased supply of food commodities to Saripul province after the drought and when traders faced problems of having limited local food in the markets.

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**Figure 1: Current supply of Wheat Flour in the market this year compared to the same time last year:**


