

In March 2019, WFP Afghanistan reached a total of 2.2 million people with food assistance in 31 out of 34 provinces. This included humanitarian response to the drought, floods, conflict displacement and treatment and prevention of moderate acute malnutrition. As part of WFP's programming bridging the humanitarian-development gap, WFP conducted asset creation activities, vocational training and seasonal support to most vulnerable families.

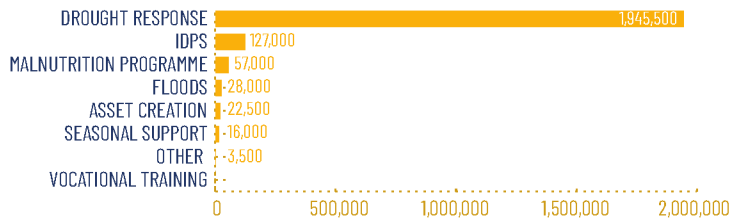

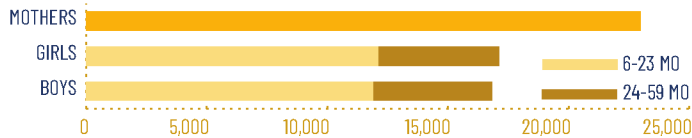

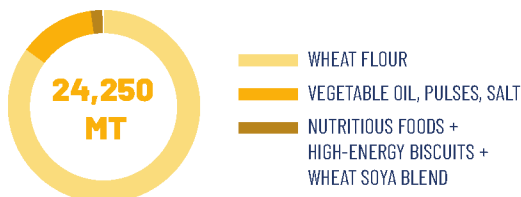

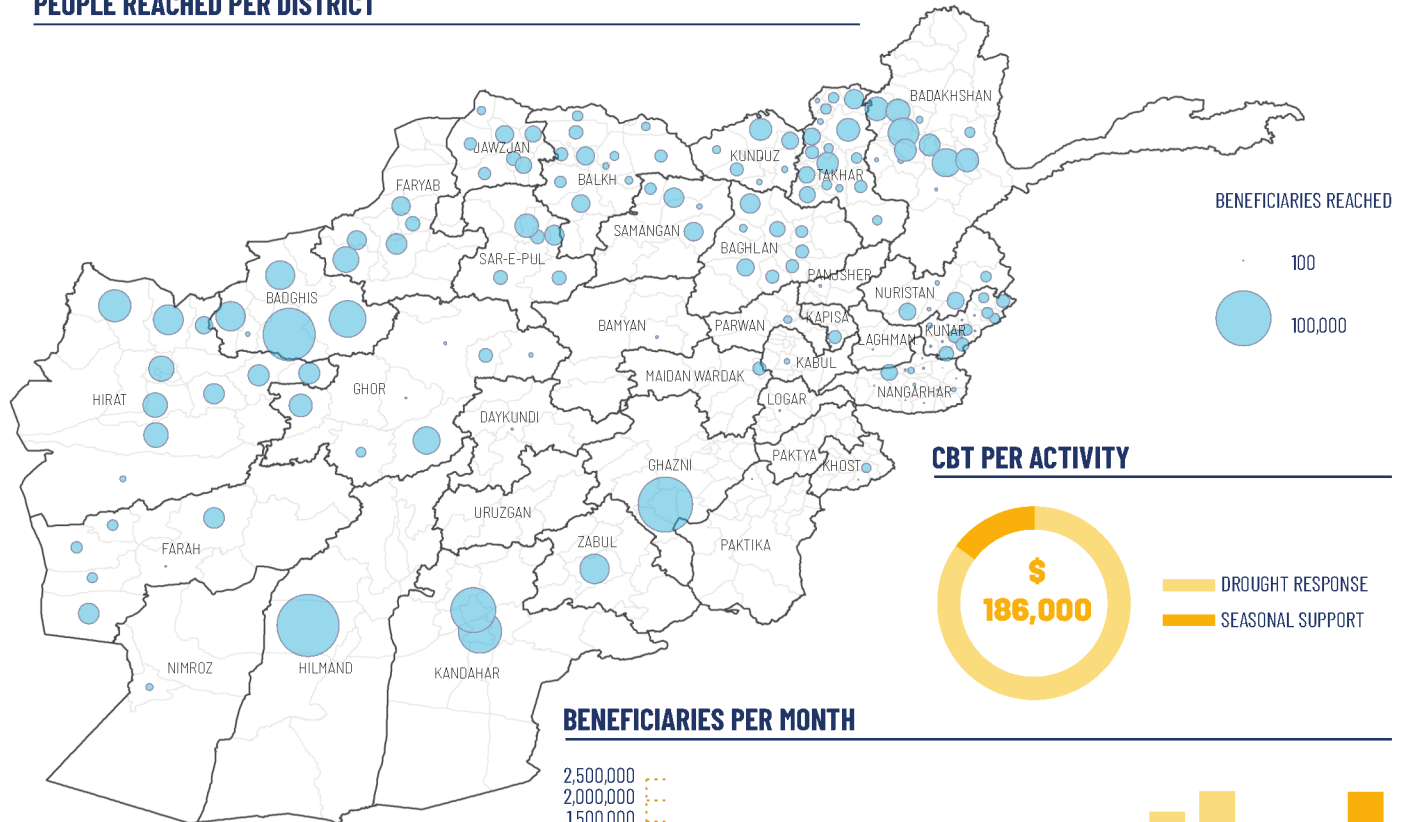
MALNOURISHED CHILDREN AND MOTHERS REACHED
