Target groups

- IDP
- Resident HH
- Returnees

General instruction

- Form gender-disaggregated groups or interview separately by gender during HH interviews
- Ask comparative questions comparing 2018 with the situation in 2017 and during the peak of the conflict.

Community background

- Describe main livelihoods in the area
- Profile the wealthier, middle and poorest households in terms of i) household demographics, ii) area of origin, iii) main income source iv) assets v) food consumption and vi) coping.

Income

- Have the main income sources changed?
- Are there new sources of income?
- How has income for the poorest changed in the past year? Remember to ask specifically about remittances and how those have changed.

Expenditure

- What is the perception of the cost of living now compared to a year ago?
- How have expenditure shares changed in the past year?
- Are there goods/services that people have stopped buying? New things people are buying?
- What are the reasons for changing consumption behaviors?
- How have prices of main food commodities developed compared to one year ago in the local market(s)? What are the reasons for changes?
- How has availability of food evolved over the past year in the local market(s)? What are the reasons for changes?
- Do poor IDPs have access to credit? If so, describe.

Coping strategies (listen, do not suggest]

- Food-based strategies: report the most common strategies.
- Livelihood coping strategies: report the most common strategies.
- Have these strategies changed compared to last year?

Food consumption

- Where does people's food come from? Purchase, aid? How has that changed in the past year?
- What are the main foods consumed by the poorest?
- Describe changes in foods consumed in the past year. Are any food items no longer consumed?

Priorities

- What are the three main priorities last year? What are the three main priorities this year?
- What kind of assistance are the poorest households receiving?
- Are poor households getting more or less assistance than last year?

Specific questions for IDPs/returnees

Ask about living conditions in IDPs area of origin – displacement, migration patterns, assistance, coping during times of hardship, intentions to stay/return (& reasons)
