



How to request CERFAM's technical assistance?

CERFAM is a regional hub for good practices in Africa. It facilitates knowledge sharing, partnership building, south south exchanges, which allows developing countries to access the best available expertise, knowledge and technical assistance to support them in their efforts to advance in the implementation of SDG2. CERFAM can help in shaping your technical assistance request to better identify the areas of technical assistance needed and the best expert(s) in our expert roster to provide relevant assistance.

When a good practice is identified, partners may come with a request for technical assistance to support its design and implementation and CERFAM facilitates these interactions. Through its networks, CERFAM reaches out to a vast roster of **experts**, which includes those from **research centres, UN agencies, private sector** and other **development partners**.

A lead expert or ad hoc expert could be requested, according to your need of assistance. Their role can be summarized as below:

Lead Expert

Lead Expert is supposed to coordinate and interact with partners during the design and implementation of their programme and decision-making process, ensuring consistency among all activities, assist them in organizing exchange and learning process (in terms of thematic and methodological input) and producing interim and final outputs.

Ad Hoc Expert

The role is to provide support on specific needs identified by Lead Partners regarding thematic expertise and support
