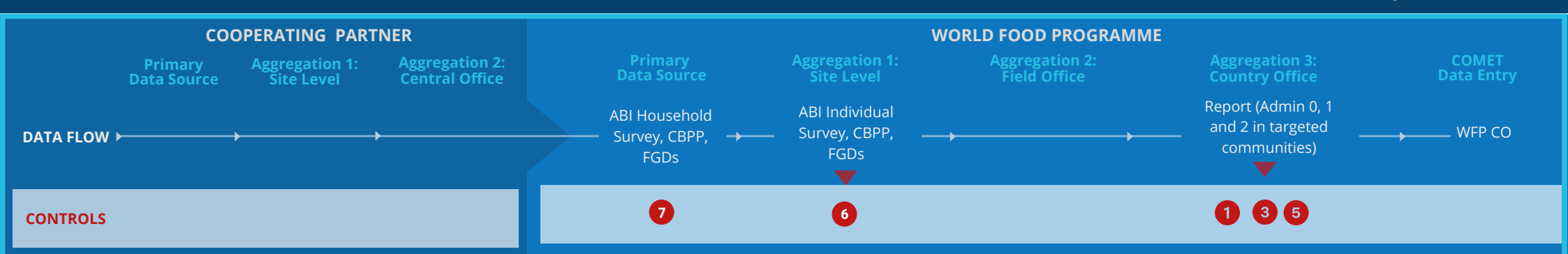

1 Documentation Review	Calculate the % of available, on-time and complete reports that are expected to contain the ABI at the CO level.	CO M&E Officer/Assistant or FFA Officer	🔄 Frequency Bi-annual ★ ★ Highly Recommended
2 Recounting & Reaggregating	N/A	N/A	N/A
3 Recomputing Formulas	Recompute the formula used to calculate the reported value of the ABI to determine a recomputed value, calculate the % error between the recomputed and reported value, and identify possible reasons for the discrepancy, if any. 4 Reconciliation & Triangulation	N/A	N/A	N/A
5 Secondary Sources	Crosscheck the validity of the internally reported benefits perceived by the household members with informal observations, identified external secondary data sources and other relevant indicators or reports mentioning the assets. Identify possible reasons for the discrepancy, if any. N/A	CO M&E Officer/Assistant or FFA Officer	🔄 Frequency Bi-annual ★ Recommended
6 On-Site Visits	Crosscheck validity of the reported benefits with the status/quality of the assets built or rehabilitated. For example, what is the status of the water pond built? Is it functional? Who has access to this asset? Ideally three site visits should take place during the project implementation: at the start, mid-time and after completion of FFA projects.	CO M&E Officer/Assistant or FFA Officer	🔄 Frequency Bi-annual ★ ★ Highly Recommended
7 Methodological Compliance	Ensure that enumerators understand the tangible and intangible assets built or rehabilitated since the beginning of the FFA programme (not just during the year). Review existing documentation on type of assets built or rehabilitated and expected benefits in the last year for the communities with FFA implementation. This information will help define which ABI questions are relevant to be asked.	CO M&E Officer/Assistant or FFA Officer	🔄 Frequency Bi-annual ★ ★ Highly Recommended
