

Evaluation of Cameroon WFP Country Strategic Plan 2018-2020





WFP has only partially met the ambitious expectations to shift to countrylevel strategic planning and management



Country Office management did not react swiftly enough to address staffing shortages



The CSP did not fully prepare WFP for the complex crises



Programme efficiency was marked by slow programme delivery, high transaction costs and recurrent pipeline breaks



Flexibility in funding and longer-term partnerships not reached



The monitoring and evaluation system remained inadequate



RECOMMENDATIONS





Strengthen the strategic approaches to nutrition, resilience and capacities Enhance strategic partnerships, funding and advocacy



Invest in an evidence base to support the strategic focus and the CSP implementation strategy



Strengthen human capacity to implement ongoing priorities and prepare for the next CSP



Improve emergency preparedness, supply chain and programme effectiveness and efficiency



Strengthen M&E, knowledge sharing and communication around results
