Zimbabwe | December 2020

Reporting period: 30th November– 29th December 2020

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HIGHLIGHTS

Household access to basic goods and services continues to be constrained due to limited incomes. A more stable macroeconomic environment is likely to create the conditions needed to strengthen the household's purchasing power in the near future.

Markets Overview

The report is based on markets from 45 districts/domains (21 rural and 24 urban); the previous reporting period covered 43 districts (20 rural and 23

Major food commodities

The prices cereals increased on average by **7%** in December. Meanwhile the price of sugar beans and cooking oil remained stable throughout the review period. The cereal price increases are a factor of increased demand against poor supply, while the stable prices are a direct result of stabilisation in the macroeconomic environment

Supply of maize grain has remained critically low at **3%** of the markets across 15 of the 45 monitored Districts; while maize meal availability has been relatively stable month on month being available in 44 districts and in 62%

Availability and price of sugar beans and cooking oil remained stable during December with very little variations between rural and urban settings.

Operational Environment Situation Update

COVID-19

As of the 29th of December 2020, Zimbabwe had 13,325 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 359 deaths, an increase of 34% and 30% respectively from the same time the previous month. A total of 1,899 cases were active with a high recovery rate at approximately 70% although the average number of daily cases continued on an upward trend to 177 cases on the 29th of December compared to 50 in November 2020. This spike in cases is partially contributed by an increase in traffic from citizens from the diaspora during the festive season and coupled with a general relaxation in observance of lockdown measures and rules. Congestion at border entry points such as the Beitbridge border post due to increased holiday traffic and human movement and limited capacity to enforce prevention and control measures could likely have contributed to this surge. While at the beginning of the month government announced they would not impose strict lockdown measures, the increase in the number of cases at the end of the month resulted in tighter lockdown measures at level 4. Given the already high prevalence of food and nutrition insecurity in the country, it is recommended for government and partners to also put in place measures to save lives and safeguard livelihoods that might be impacted by the COVID-19 restrictive measures.

Inflation and Exchange Rate

The Zimbabwean dollar has remained stable against other currencies on both the official and parallel foreign currency exchange market since July 2020 after the government had introduced the forex auction system in June. The foreign exchange market auction held on the 21st of December 2020 set the exchange rate at ZWL81.79 to the United States Dollar, which is comparable to ZWL81.81 per dollar at the end of November. This has contributed to stabilisation of prices for good and commodities and is reflected in the decrease in inflation.

Inflation decreased in November with the year on year inflation decreasing to 402% from 471.3% while the monthly inflation rate dropped to 3.2% from 4.37% in October. This was largely driven by the general decrease in the cost of food although some commodities such as the staple (maize grain and maize meal) noted price increases. The cost of fuel also increased with diesel prices increasing by 21% during December however, petrol prices remained comparable to the prices prevailing in November 2020. The cost of living remains very high as the country is still operating under a hyperinflationary environment coupled with poor incomes and supressed sources of livelihood.

Overall market trends for food basket commodities

Maize Grain

Maize grain remains unavailable with indications of depleting households stocks. This increased demand has influenced price increases mostly in cereal deficit areas.

Maize meal

Availability generally remained relatively stable with the exception of surplus cereal producing areas where poor availability was noted.

Sugar beans

Availability of sugar beans in the current month was relatively stable.

Cooking Oil

Availability remains high with the commodity available on most markets.



GMB depots are selling the commodity at an average price of ZWL3.50/kg (ZWL175/50kg), although most depots do not have the commodity due to the poor distribution of depots.


Prices slightly increased in December rising by 7% on average across the country. Mobile money transactions incurred an average premium of 5% per transaction.

Prices remained stable.
Traders in Mbire, Harare and
Epworth were only accepting
USD payments for the
commodity. Mobile money
prices were about 17% higher
than cash prices.

Prices remained stable in both urban and rural areas.
Payments in mobile money incurred an average premium of 6%.

Food Commodity Prices in Foreign Currency (US\$ terms)

The average price of maize grain and maize meal remained stable at an average of U\$\$0.32 and U\$\$0.50 per kilogram. When compared to the same time last year (December 2019) as well as the two year average, these prices are comparable at an average price of U\$\$0.30/kg while maize meal was selling at an average price of U\$\$0.49/kg. The same is true for sugar beans whose current price of U\$\$2.23/kg is the same as that reported in December 2019. While cooking oil prices have been stable over the last six months, the current price of U\$\$1.54/L is 21% lower than the 2yr average as well as the price reported in December 2019. This price reduction is likely a factor of increased supply of



the locally produced product on the market which is cheaper compare to imports which were more readily available compared to the local product during the same period last year.

Non-Food Commodities: Laundry and Bathing soap

Laundry and bathing soap were available in 90% and 93% of the monitored markets respectively with no significant difference in availability between urban and rural areas. Laundry soap was retailing at an average of **ZWL125.48/bar** in local currency and **US\$1.33** in rural districts while in it was being sold at an average price of **ZWL108.53/bar** or **USD\$1.14** in urban districts. These prices are comparable to the prices reported in November.

The average price for bathing soap in the rural districts was **ZWL64.47** per unit whilst in the urban centres it was 7% lower at **ZWL60.20** per unit. Most traders were accepting USD payments at **US\$0.74** per unit. In the urban districts the price was lowest in Marondera urban at **ZWL42.79** and most expensive in Plumtree at **ZWL189.50**. In the rural centres the average price was lowest in Chipinge at **ZWL35.31** and most expensive in Muzarabani and Chiredzi at **ZWL95.00**.

Rural markets – review of availability and prices in Zimbabwe dollars (ZWL)

Maize Grain

Maize grain remains generally unavailable across all rural markets being available in 2% of the monitored rural markets. As the peak lean season looms, which is characterised by depleted households cereal stock, household's reliance on markets and demand for the commodity has spiked, pushing prices up especially in cereal deficit areas while surplus cereal producing areas have relatively stable prices.

During the month under review, average selling prices increased by 7% from ZWL 30.70/kg recorded in November to ZWL32.74/kg in December. The average price for mobile money transactions were ZWL35.32/kg. Mudzi (a cereal deficit area) had the highest average price at ZWL38.89/kg whilst Nkayi (also a cereal deficit area but in close proximity to surplus producing areas like Gokwe South) had the lowest average price at ZWL27.78/kg and surplus producing areas such as Chipinge (mainly from agroecological region 1 and 2) noted stable prices when compared to last month. It was also noted that market availability was generally higher in cereal deficit areas as compared to surplus areas where households might be consuming from own production or relying more on farmer to farmer sales thereby reducing demand on the formal market. For more details on district prices (see annex 3).

Unrefined Maize Meal

Unrefined maize meal was available in **49%** of the rural districts down from **53%** in the month of November.

The price of the maize meal rose by 10% from ZWL46.18/kg in November to ZWL50.94/kg in December (Figure 3). This is typical for this time of the year when more households rely on maize grain as an alternative due to depleted cereal stocks at household level. All markets monitored in Buhera, Mount Darwin and Muzarabani did not have maize meal in stock.

Sugar Beans


Availability of sugar beans increased by **6%** from November being available in **66%** of the rural markets. Mount Darwin is the only district that reported unavailability out of the 21 monitired districts, while Bulawayo rural, Rushinga, Binga and Mwenezi reported availability in all markets monitored within these districts.

Sugar beans were selling at an average price of **ZWL217.18/kg** up from **ZWL212.06/kg** in November. Mudzi reported the biggest price (increase?) of **15**% month on month while Mangwe had the biggest price change year on year at more than **400**% (annex 7). Mangwe district also recorded the highest price during the current reporting period at **ZWL65/kg**.


Cooking Oil

Cooking oil remains available in most of the markets (91.8%). However, two districts in Manicaland Province indicated poor supply of the commodity; Buhera District reported no cooking oil stocks on the market and Chipinge District reported poor availability with the commodity only available in 41% of the markets (compared to 71% last month). This is likely a supply chain issue and WFP will continue to monitor the situation closely.


The commodity was selling at an averge price of **ZWL152.59/L**, a slight increase from **ZWL150.93/L** in November. Traders were charging a 6% premium on average for mobile money transactions which had an average price of **ZWL160.81/L**.





Urban markets – review of availability and prices in Zimbabwe dollars (ZWL)

Maize Grain

Maize grain remains largely unavailable in urban markets; the commodity was reported to be available in 15% of all urban monitored markets, distributed across 9 of 24 monitored urban districts. Market availability was very poor with just 2 Districts (Norton (20.5%) and Redcliff (33.3%)) reporting more than 20% availability.

There was a marginal decrease in the average price of maize grain in bond notes from <code>ZWL29.29/kg</code> in November to <code>ZWL29.24/kg</code> in December. The highest price was recorded in Masvingo Urban markets averaging <code>ZWL36.11/kg</code> whilst Chiredzi urban markets recorded the lowest average prices at <code>ZWL25.00/kg</code>. Traders charged an average of <code>8%</code> premium on mobile money. Epworth traders were only accepting USD for maize grain purchases.

Maize Meal

Maize meal was available across all monitored urban districts and in 76% of monitored markets, indicating an increase of 3% in availability from the previous month. Four districts reported availability in less than 50% of the monitored markets: Kariba urban with only 12% availability, Nembudziya (32%), Buhera (33%) and Gweru urban (46%). The average price of maize meal slightly increased from ZWL45.13/kg in November to ZWL46.90/kg in December. The highest price was in Redcliff markets at an average of ZWL53.17/kg and was lowest in Kadoma urban at ZWL33.20/kg.


Sugar Beans

Sugar beans were available in all the urban districts - save for Mount Darwin, and in **83.2%** of monitored markets, which marks a slight a decrease from **86%** reported in November. Availability was lowest in Kariba urban and Buhera at **29%** and **33%** respectively.


The average price for sugar beans was **ZWL198.65/kg** with **the** highest prices reported in Plumtree at **ZWL261.44/kg**, and the lowest prices reported in Kadoma urban at **ZWL137.50/kg**.

Cooking Oil


Cooking oil was available in all monitored districts and in 92% of all monitored markets. The current average price of ZWL142.98/L is comparable to the price reported in November (ZWL139.56/L). However, when compared to the 12 month average, these prices are 40% higher (Figure 9). Plumtree had the highest prices at ZWL197.34/L and the lowest was Kadoma at ZWL105.33/L.





Annex 1: Sample and data collection

This report provides an update on WFP food basket commodities availability and prices. It covers the period from the **28**th **November to 29**^{tht} **December 2020** and is based on interviews with **1,877** traders (**1,510** in rural districts and **367** in urban districts) across 45 districts (21 rural and 24 urban). Annexes 10-12 explain the trend arrows used in the highlights.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions most of the data collection is virtual. In the current reporting period (28 November to 29 December 2020), the proportion of remote to face-face monitoring was comparable to the previous month at 80%. Given the advent of the second wave of COVID-19 in the country, it is strongly recommended that data collection be collected remotely.



Annex 13: Background and methodology

Checking Availability at market level: If any of the interviewed traders in a market reports having sold a commodity within the last week, the commodity is considered available in this market. Availability at country-level (district-level) is calculated as the share of markets with commodity availability across the country (across districts). Missing data indicate that none of the interviewed traders generally trades the commodity.

The harmonised weekly market monitoring is being conducted by WFP in partnership with members of the Cash Assistance Working Group (CWG), including World Vision International, CARE, Oxfam, Aquaculture Zimbabwe, Caritas Zimbabwe, Christian Aid, GOAL Zimbabwe, HOCIC, Mercy Corps, IRC, ORAP, Zimbabwe Red Cross Society, Action Aid, LEAD, LGDA, CAFOD, AfriCare, CTDO, ADRA, MDTC, Plan International and WeEffect.
