Zimbabwe | February 2021

Reporting period: 1st - 28th February 2021

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HIGHLIGHTS

In February, COVID-19 restrictive measures continued to negatively affect urban livelihoods. Incomes derived from the informal sector further decreased due to restrictions that continued throughout the month. Notable price increases were observed during the reporting period for all major food commodities.

Markets Profile

The report is based on markets from **39** districts/domains (**16** rural and **23** urban); the previous reporting period covered **38** districts (**17** rural and **21** urban). 81% of the interviews were done remotely whilst 19% were done face to face.

Major food commodity Prices

The price of the major food commodities increased in February by an average of **8**%; specifically, maize grain increased by **15**%, maize meal by **7**%, sugar beans by **4**% and cooking oil by **4**%. The recorded rise in prices is a factor of increased demand against poor supply.

Supply of maize grain remained critically low, reported to be available in only 3% of monitored markets across 12 out of the 39 monitored districts; while supply of maize meal slightly decreased from an average of 72% in January to 71% in February, although the commodity was reported to be available in all monitored markets.

Availability of **vegetable oil** remained stable during the month, slightly higher in the urban markets than the rural. There was a 4% increase in the average price of the commodity. Availability of **sugar beans** slightly reduced, and the price rose by 4%.

Operational Environment Situation Update

COVID-19

The raising of the national lockdown from level 2 to level 4 at the beginning of 2021, followed by a two-week extension mid-January and subsequent relaxation of lockdown measures from level 4 to level 1 at the start of March, has led to a significant reduction in COVID-19 daily cases and deaths. After experiencing a sharp increase in the number of cases in January, the country started recording a decline in February; the running average rose to a peak of 956 confirmed cases on 14 January and then dropped to an average of 240 cases towards the end of the month, a declining trend which continued into February and March. On March 9 2021, Zimbabwe recorded 32 new cases and 2 new deaths from COVID-19. The cumulative number of confirmed cases increased from 33,548 including 1,217 deaths on 1 February 2021 to 36,321 cases, including 33,919 recoveries and 1,489 deaths on 9 March 2021. As a result, the country relaxed the lockdown measures from level 4 to level 1 at the start of March 2021.

The government received the first consignment of 200,000 doses of the Sinopharm vaccine to immunise 100,000 individuals and started the rollout on the 18th of February. Front line workers were prioritised for vaccination. More donations are expected from the government of China and the African Union, and the country has also purchased more doses (600,000) from China. As of the 9th of March 2021, a total of 35,761 frontline workers have been vaccinated.

Inflation and Exchange Rate

The official exchange rate remains relatively stable with the Zimbabwean dollar trading at **ZWL83.89:1USD on** 26 February 2021 **compared** to **ZWL82.68:1USD** on 26 January 2021.

Zimbabwe's annual inflation slightly decreased from 363% in January to 322% in February. The downward trend has been consistent for the past five consecutive months prior to the slight increase (of 13.71%) recorded in January, which was largely driven by rising food prices and increased cost of fuel among other factors.

Overall market trends for food basket commodities in rural and urban markets

Maize Grain



Maize grain supply remained critically low, reported to be available in only **3%** of all rural and urban surveyed markets.

Maize meal

Availability **increased** in both rural and urban markets by **21%** and **6%** respectively.

Sugar beans

Availability of sugar beans **increased** by **8%** in rural markets but decreased by **4%** in the urban markets.

Vegetable Oil

Availability remained high and stable with the commodity available in most urban (93%) and rural markets (90%).



Maize grain prices increased by 6% in rural markets and 19% in urban markets, linked to limited supply and increased demand for the commodity. Grain Marketing Board (GMB) continued to sell the commodity at ZWL3.50/kg (ZWL175/50kg).


In February, maize meal price **increased** in both rural (**6%**) and urban (**8%**) markets compared to the previous month, due to increased demand driven by depleted household cereal stocks.

Prices **increased** in both rural (**2%**) and urban (**7%**) markets. Traders in Mangwe, Tsholotsho and Beitbridge were only accepting USD and/ ZAR payments.

Prices **increased** in both rural and urban markets by (6%) and (7%) respectively.

Food Commodity Prices in Foreign Currency (US\$ terms)

Cereal prices rose during the reporting period; the average price of maize grain increased by 9% from US\$0.35/kg in January to US\$0.38/kg in February, and the price of maize meal saw a slight increase of 5% from US\$0.56/kg in January to US\$0.59/kg in February. Sugar beans were selling at an average price of US\$2.37/kg in February, which is comparable to January (US\$2.36/kg). The current prices for sugar beans are about 48% higher compared to the same period last year (February 2020). Vegetable oil prices increased by 4% from an average of US\$1.69/L in January to US\$1.75/L in February. The minor price increases noted during this reporting period are likely a result of the residual effects of the fuel price increase recorded last month, coupled with a general increase in the cost of doing business for importers and producers as a result of a declining macroeconomic environment.



Non-Food Commodities: Laundry and Bathing soap

Laundry and bathing soap were available in 85% and 87% of the monitored markets respectively, which is comparable to last month (85% and 88%). Laundry soap was selling at an average of ZWL117.92/bar in local currency and US\$1.22/bar, recording a 15% and 17% price decrease respectively compared to January. Availability for laundry soap and bathing soap increased by 15% in urban markets and 9% in rural markets during the reporting period. The price for laundry soap was 22% higher in rural markets than in urban markets, whilst that of bathing soap was 19% higher in rural markets.

The average price for bathing soap in the rural districts was **ZWL69.24** per unit, which is an **11% increase** compared to the previous month, whilst in urban markets it cost an average of ZWL58.42 per unit, which is on par with the average price reported in January. Most traders were accepting USD payments at US\$0.64 per unit, indicating a 19% decrease compared to the previous month (US\$0.79).

Rural markets - review of availability and prices in Zimbabwe dollars (ZWL)

Maize Grain

Maize grain supply remained critically low across rural markets, the commodity was reported to be available in only **3%** of all monitored markets, similar to January 2021. Although the trend is typical for the peak lean season, current availability is much lower compared to the 5yr average of 40%. The only districts with availability above 15% were Muzarabani (**16%**) and Mwenezi (**19%**).

During the month under review, average selling prices **increased by 6%** from ZWL37.75/kg in January to **ZWL40/kg** in February (Figure 3). The highest bond note price was recorded in Mwenezi ZWL47.11/kg and the lowest in Binga at ZWL28.06/kg. For more details on district prices see <u>annex 3</u>.

Unrefined Maize Meal

Availability of unrefined maize meal rebounded from the dip observed in previous months, it was reported at an average of **62%** in February up from 41% reported in January, 49% in December and 53% in November. Bulawayo and Masvingo had 100% availability in the monitored markets whilst Bikita (**9%**) and Muzarabani (**5%**) had the lowest recorded availability percentages. Muzarabani reported no availability in December 2020 and January 2021, a situation partially attributed to some availability of maize grain in the District, which is more preferred by households.

The price of maize meal **rose by 6%** from ZWL55.59/kg in January 2021 to **ZWL59.12/kg** in February 2021 (Figure 4). The peak of the lean season is likely to push prices up due to increased demand caused by depleted household cereal stocks (annex 5).

Sugar Beans


Sugar beans were available in **60%** of monitored markets in February, up from 52% in January 2021. Bikita reported unavailability of the commodity, whilst only Bulawayo, Binga and Masvingo districts recorded 100% avalability.

The price of sugar beans was relatively stable, marginally increasing by **2%** from ZWL247.84/kg in January 2021 to **ZWL252.68/kg** in February 2021 (Figure 5). The average price was highest in Matobo at **ZWL323.05/kg** and lowest in UMP at **ZWL191.82/kg** (annex 7).


Vegetable Oil

Vegetable oil remained available in most of the markets (90%), in line with what was reported in recent months. Muzarabani recorded the lowest availability for the commodity at 34% whilst the rest of the monitored districts recorded above 80% availability.


The commodity was selling at an average price of **ZWL178.22/L** up by 6% from ZWL167.94/L in January 2021 (Figure 6). An average of 8% premium was charged for mobile money transactions for the commodity.





Urban markets – review of availability and prices in Zimbabwe dollars (ZWL)

Maize Grain

Maize grain remained also largely unavailable in urban markets; reported availability dropped from 5% in January to 3% in February 2021. Maize grain was available in Mutare urban (20%), Chiredzi urban (17%), Norton (12%), Kariba urban (11%), Gweru urban (7%) and Masvingo urban (3%).

The average price of maize grain **rose by 19%** from ZWL31.50/kg in January 2021 to **ZWL37.60/kg** in February. Gweru Urban reported the highest price at **ZWL45.00/kg** whilst Kariba recorded the lowest price for the commodity at **ZWL33.34/kg** (annex 2).

Maize Meal

Maize meal was in supply across all monitored urban domains, reported to be available in **81%** of all monitored markets, up from 75% in the previous month. The lowest availability was in Kariba Urban at **37%**. (annex 4).

The average price of maize meal **increased by 8%** from ZWL54.33/kg in January 2021 to **ZWL58.48/kg** in February 2021. The highest price in the current month was recorded in Gokwe North (Nembudziya) at an average of **ZWL67.18/kg** which was also the district with the highest price in January at ZWL60.00/kg. The lowest price was recorded in Plumtree at **ZWL46.60/kg** which was also the district with the lowest price in January 2021 at ZWL31.00/kg.


Sugar Beans

Sugar beans were available in all monitored urban districts, and in **77%** of monitored markets compared to 81% in the month of January. Availability was lowest in Rusape urban at an average of **30%**, whilst all the other districts had availability above 50% (annex 6).


The average price for sugar beans in February was **ZWL228.08/kg** up from ZWL213.99/kg in January, marking a **7% increase**. The highest price was in Rusape urban at **ZWL273.90/kg** and lowest in Beitbridge Urban at **ZWL198.90/kg**.

Vegetable Oil


Cooking oil was available across all monitored urban domains and in **93%** of all monitored markets. The average price in February was **ZWL169.89/L** up from ZWL158.27/L in January, marking a **7%** increase. Beitbridge Urban had the highest prices at **ZWL191.50/L** and the lowest was Plumtree at **ZWL147.00/L**. (annex 8).





Annex 1: Sample and data collection

This report provides an update on WFP food basket commodities availability and prices. It covers the period from the 1st of February to 28th of February 2021 and is based on interviews with 1,271 traders, including 655 in rural districts and 616 in urban districts, across 39 districts/domains (16 rural districts and 23 urban domains). Annexes 10-12 explain the trend arrows used in the highlights.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions most of the data collection is virtual. The proportion of remote to face-face monitoring decreased from 86.5% in January to **81%** in the current reporting period. Given the ongoing presence of COVID-19 in the country, it is strongly recommended that data continue to be collected remotely.



Annex 13: Background and methodology

Checking Availability at market level: If any of the interviewed traders in a market reports having sold a commodity within the last week, the commodity is considered available in this market. Availability at country-level (district-level) is calculated as the share of markets with commodity availability across the country (across districts). Missing data indicate that none of the interviewed traders generally trades the commodity.

The harmonised weekly market monitoring is being conducted by WFP in partnership with members of the Cash Assistance Working Group (CWG), including World Vision International, CARE, Oxfam, Aquaculture Zimbabwe, Caritas Zimbabwe, Christian Aid, GOAL Zimbabwe, HOCIC, Mercy Corps, IRC, ORAP, Zimbabwe Red Cross Society, Action Aid, LEAD, LGDA, CAFOD, AfriCare, CTDO, ADRA, MDTC, Plan International and WeEffect.
