Policy results largely positive



Broader scope, quality of support and systematization of WFP's engagement



WFP is seen as respected SSTC broker in school feeding and, increasingly, in nutrition



Opportunities to expand WFP's strategic use of SSTC



There are risks related to over-reliance on extra-budgetary resources
