

WFP School Feeding Programmes in 2020

THIS HAS BEEN AN UNPRECEDENTED YEAR. DUE TO SCHOOL **CLOSURES AMID COVID-19, 370 MILLION CHILDREN WORLDWIDE LOST ACCESS TO SCHOOL MEALS IN 161 COUNTRIES. WFP HAD** TO ADAPT ITS OWN PROGRAMMES TO MANAGE THE CRISIS:



WFP provided school meals or snacks for 15 MILLION CHILDREN of which **50% WERE GIRLS**



WFP assisted 7 MILLION CHILDREN during school closures with alternative take home rations in the form of food or cash




In 2020, WFP implemented or supported school feeding programmes in 74 COUNTRIES



- WFP provides alternative take-home rations in the form of food or cash during school closures amid COVID-19 (43 countries)
- WFP provides direct implementation and technical assistance (61 countries)
- **WFP** provides **only technical assistance** to the government (13 countries)
