WFP provided food assistance through cash, vouchers and in-kind distributions in 12 countries in Southern Africa.

CHILDREN RECEIVED SCHOOL MEALS

WFP provided school meals to 1.7 million children across 7 countries in the region.

 **2.5 MILLION PREGNANT AND BREASTFEEDING WOMEN AND CHILDREN RECEIVED NUTRITION ASSISTANCE**

WFP treated 1.4 million pregnant and breastfeeding women and children for moderate acute malnutrition and provided preventative nutrition support to 1.1 million women and children.
