

COUNTRY STRATEGIC PLAN focused on seven strategic outcomes



access to adequate and nutritious **food**

meet basic food and **nutrition** needs of shock

access to nutritious food of children in affected people chronically food insecure areas

Improve nutrition status of targeted people in prioritized areas

enhance livelihoods of small holder farmers

efficient supply chains and information/ communications technology

efficient logistic support services


