


- During the week under review, wheat flour, wheat grain and rice prices decreased slightly compared to last week, while prices remain significantly higher compared to the same time last year and average levels
- The price of diesel decreased by seven percent However, it remains 89 percent higher compared to the same time last year. Nationally, the average price of diesel stands at 103 AFN/L.
- Due to stable money supply (USD) by the Central bank, the value of the Afghani (AFN) remained stable against the US Dollar, depreciating only marginally by 0.3 percent. However, severe cash shortages continue to limit economic activity within banks and local markets
- Pastoralist Terms of Trade (TOT) remain stable compared to last week. TOT for both pastoralists and casual laborers remains significantly lower by 26 and 32 percent, respectively, compared to the same time last year.

Main food commodity prices such as wheat grain, wheat flour and rice prices decreased slightly compared to last week. For second consecutive week, significant changes in the main food commodity prices occurred in Uruzgan, one of the most vulnerable provinces Wheat grain, pulses and some other food and none food commodity prices were increased compared to last week. Daikundi is the second province in terms of experiencing higher prices of food commodities and diesel prices at country level.



Weekly Food Basket Prices:

The average price of WFP's basic food basket has decreased by 0.2 percent compared to last week, but remains significantly higher (26 percent) compared to the same time last year in dollar value.

Food basket price remains higher than national average in the southern part of the country.

Diesel Prices:

The national average price of diesel decreased by seven percent compared to the previous week. However, record high fuel prices continue to impact transportation costs. Marginal decrease in prices of main food items are also associated with decrease in prices of diesel during this week.
