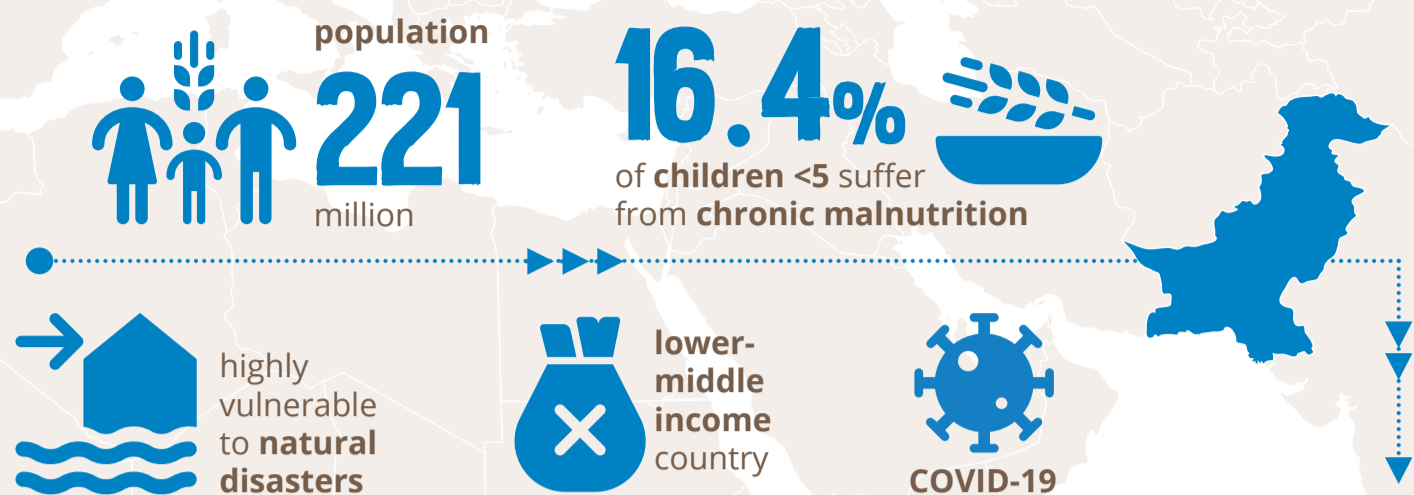
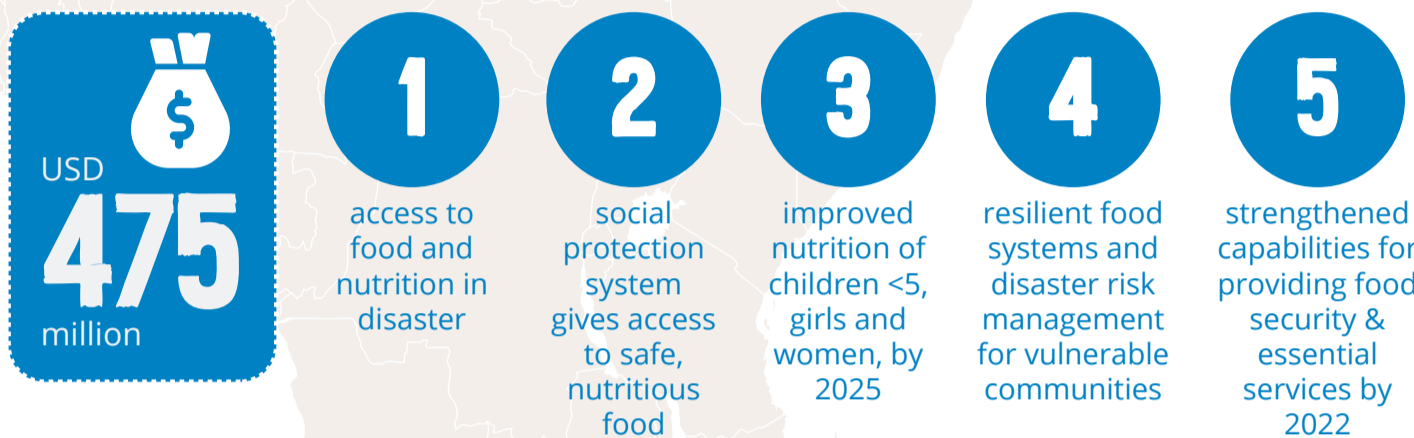


COUNTRY CONTEXT



COUNTRY STRATEGIC PLAN focused on five strategic outcomes



EVALUATION covers WFP activities implemented between 2018 and September 2021



CONCLUSIONS

- Considerable variation between and within provinces which requires WFP to tailor its support to ensure that it meets local needs
- Progress made in several areas, notably in emergency support, social protection and nutrition
- WFP partnership with the Government was more focused at operational than at strategic level
- The CSP envisioned shift of focus from crisis response to resilience and root causes was not fully operationalized
- The CSP placed attention on supporting women and girls, but this alone does not demonstrate a gendered approach

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1 Support the Government to develop strategies to enhance food and nutrition security, while being able to respond to crises
- 2 Review WFP's fundraising, partnership and advocacy plan with a view to explore new funding sources and leverage domestic financing
- 3 Deepen WFP's strategic system-wide and operational partnership with government partners and civil society organizations
- 4 Intensify efforts to promote gender equality, accountability to affected populations and protection
