Considerable variation between and within provinces which requires WFP to tailor its support to ensure that it meets local needs

The CSP was well positioned with regard to national polici and was aligned with the UN Sustainble Development Framework



WFP partnership with the Government was more focused at operational than at strategic level

The CSP placed attention on supporting women and girls, but this alone does not demonstrate a gendered approach

The CSP envisioned shift of focus from crisis response to resilience and root causes was not fully operationalized

Progress made in several areas,

notably in emergency support,

social protection and nutrition

RECOMMENDATIONS

Support the Government to develop strategies to enhance food and nutrition security, while being able to respond to crises

Review WFP's fundraising, partnership and advocacy plan with a view to explore new funding sources and leverage domestic financing



Deepen WFP's strategic system-wide and operational partnership with government partners and civil society organizations



Intensify efforts to promote gender equality, accountability to affected populations and protection
