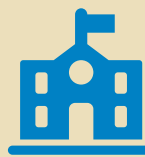
WFP provided school meals or snacks for **15.5 MILLION** children of which **6 MILLION** live in emergency context



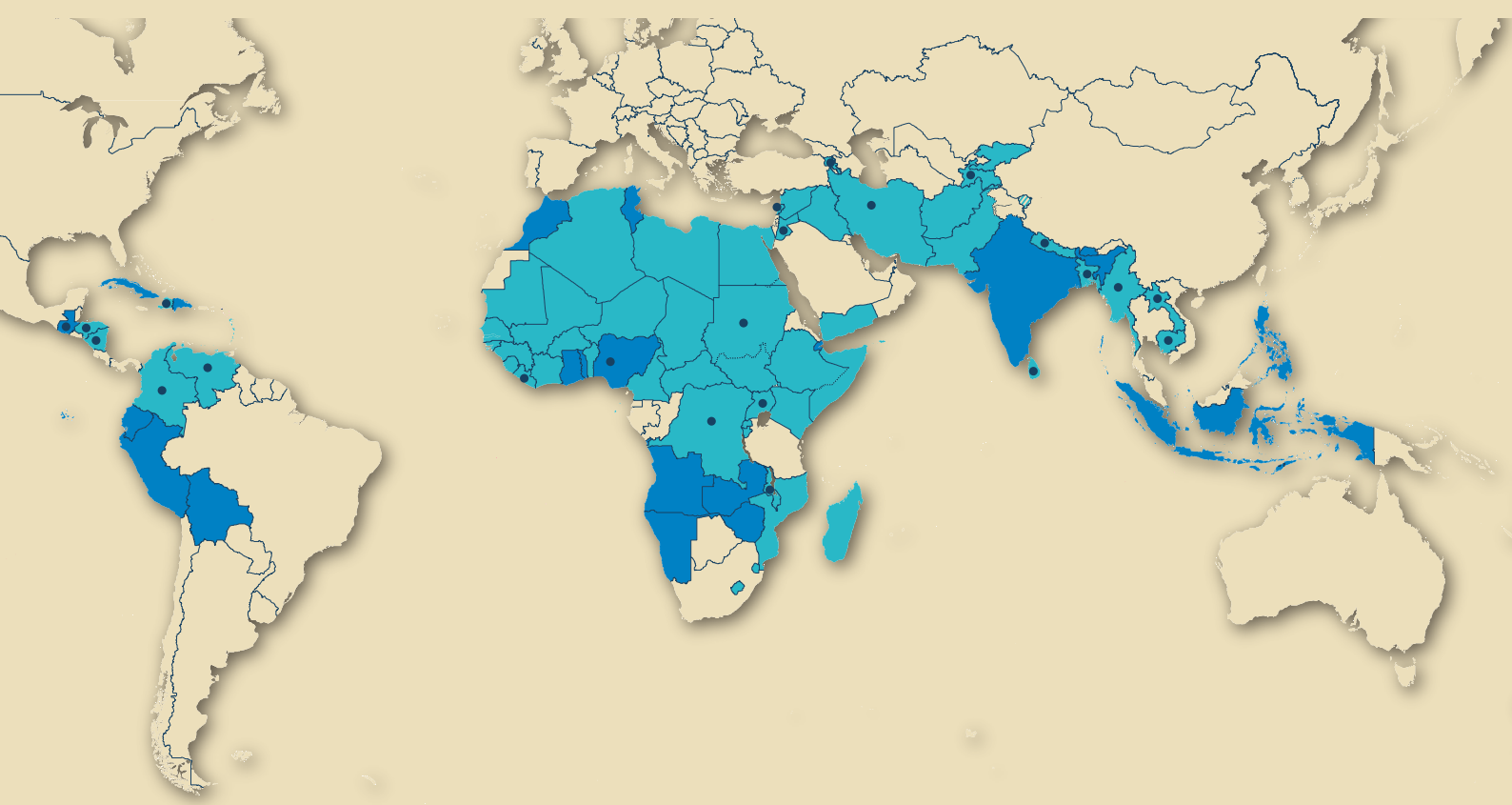
WFP scaled up school feeding operations in humanitarian or fragile settings in **16 COUNTRIES** and advanced the transition to national ownership in **14 COUNTRIES**



In **39 COUNTRIES** WFP provides support to smallholder farmers through home-grown school feeding programmes

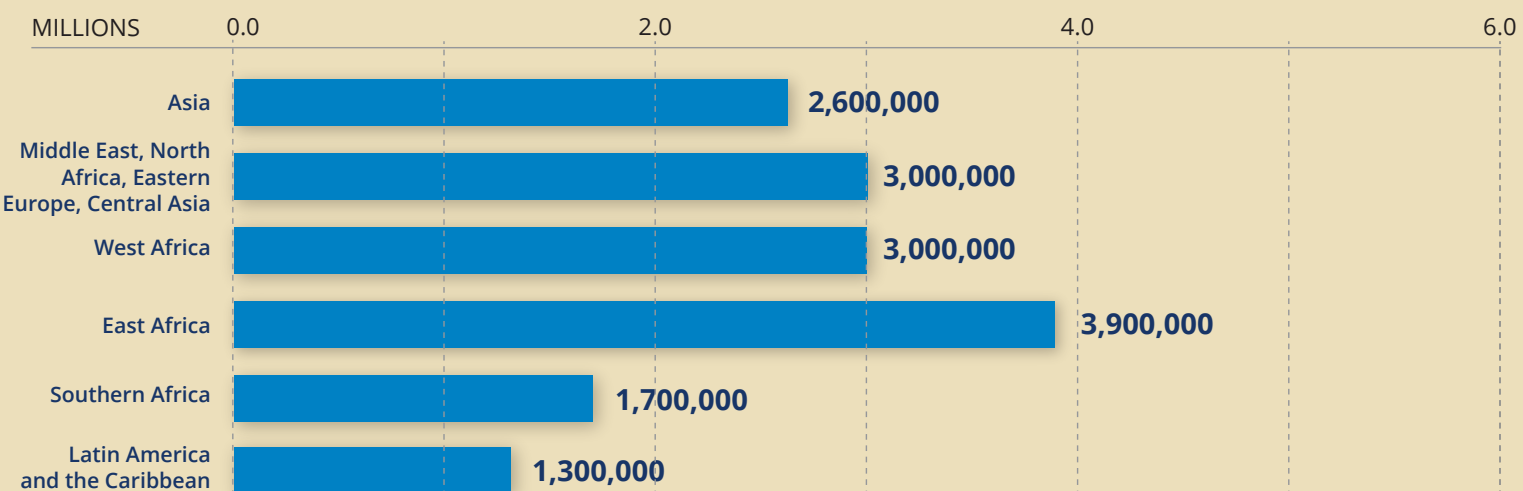


In 2021, WFP implemented or supported school feeding programmes in **78 COUNTRIES**.



- WFP provides **alternative take-home rations in the form of food or cash during school closures amid COVID-19** (23 countries)
- WFP provides **direct implementation and technical assistance** (57 countries)
- WFP provides **only technical assistance** to the government (21 countries)
