

## **WFP School Feeding Programmes in 2021**



WFP provided school meals or snacks for 15.5 MILLION children of which 6 MILLION live in emergency context




WFP scaled up school feeding operations in humanitarian or fragile settings in 16 COUNTRIES and advanced the transition to national ownership in 14 COUNTRIES



In **39 COUNTRIES** WFP provides support to smallholder farmers through home-grown school feeding programmes



In 2021, WFP implemented or supported school feeding programmes in 78 COUNTRIES.



- WFP provides alternative take-home rations in the form of food or cash during school closures amid COVID-19 (23 countries)
- WFP provides direct implementation and technical assistance (57 countries) WFP provides only technical assistance to the government (21 countries)
