NUTRITION AND FOOD SECURITY



MOU-TRIPARTITE COOPERATION AGREEMENT signed with the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sports (MoEYS) and the Ministry of State Administration (MSA) on school meals and a **LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING** signed with the Ministry of Social Solidarity and Inclusion on nutrition-sensitive social protection



National **SCHOOL MEALS PROGRAMME BUDGET INCREASED THREEFOLD FROM USD 8 MILLION TO USD 22 MILLION**, through WFP's joint advocacy increasing allocation per meal per student from 25 cents to 42 cents.

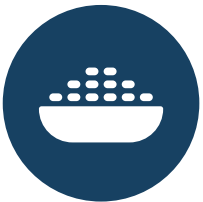

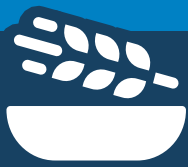
