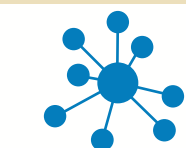

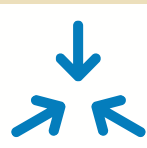

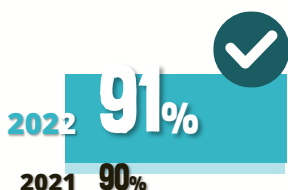

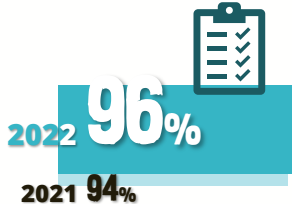

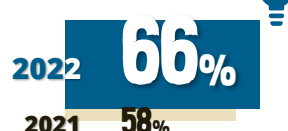

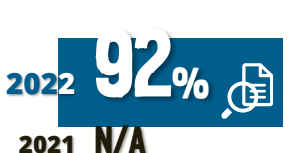

WFP draft policies and draft country strategic plans which refer explicitly to evaluation evidence

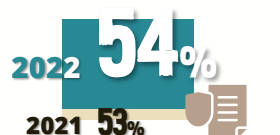

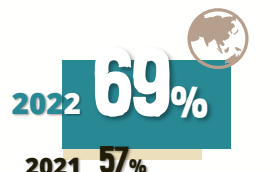

Active policies evaluated

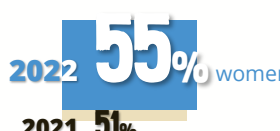


Country offices with at least one decentralized evaluation completed in the I/CSP

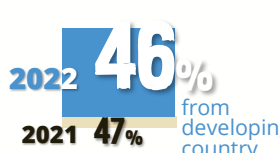


CAPACITY

Geographical diversity in evaluation teams

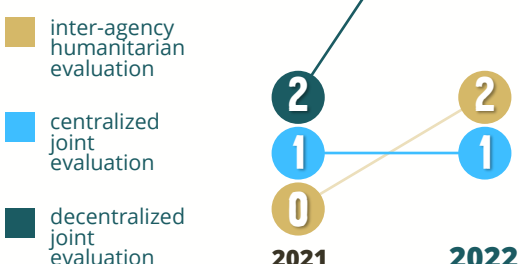


PERFORMANCE OF EVALUATION FUNCTION



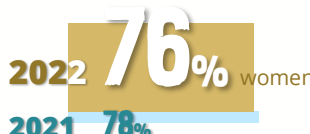
