COUNTRY STRATEGIC PLAN (CSP) focused on six strategic outcomes



Affected population have timely access to food and nutrition (9%)



Food insecure people have improved nutrition by 2025 (46%)



Vulnerable communities have improved food security and resilience to shocks (26%)



Government of Nepal has strengthened capabilities (14%)



Inclusive and coherent policy frameworks support Government efforts to zero hunger (3%)



Humanitarian and Development Partners have access to reliable common services (2%)
