OVERVIEW

Cambodia has seen considerable economic transformation in recent years. However, a sizeable portion of the population remains vulnerable to food insecurity, poverty and shocks. The COVID-19 pandemic and climate-induced crises have worsened their situation and put the near-poor at risk.

To sustain the upward momentum and create a strong foundation for human capital development and climate change adaptation, WFP is working closely with the Royal Government of Cambodia, aligning its plan with the UN Sustainable Development Cooperation Framework for Cambodia 2024-2028 and the Government's Pentagonal Strategy 2023-2028. The WFP goal is to ensure that no one is left behind and to promote people-centric progress through access to nutritious food, transformative food systems, climate change adaptation, and disaster risk reduction. Recognizing the changing socio-economic landscape and Cambodia's growing prominence in regional and global development, WFP has gradually shifted from direct implementation to supporting an enabling environment through technical assistance.

WFP is committed to working hand in hand with the government, partners, and communities to enhance human capital through nutrition and social protection, foster climate change resilience via food systems and disaster risk management and provide emergency response. WFP's approach is grounded in evidence and gender-inclusive strategies and reflects a collaborative journey with the government and partners.

DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT

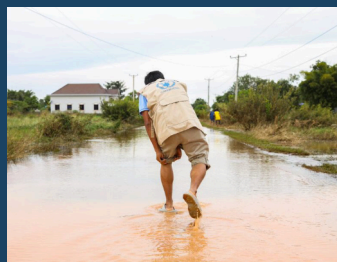
We support authorities and communities in understanding climate risks and preparing timely responses. Together, we establish protocols for early assistance, ensuring effective support before hazards escalate.
