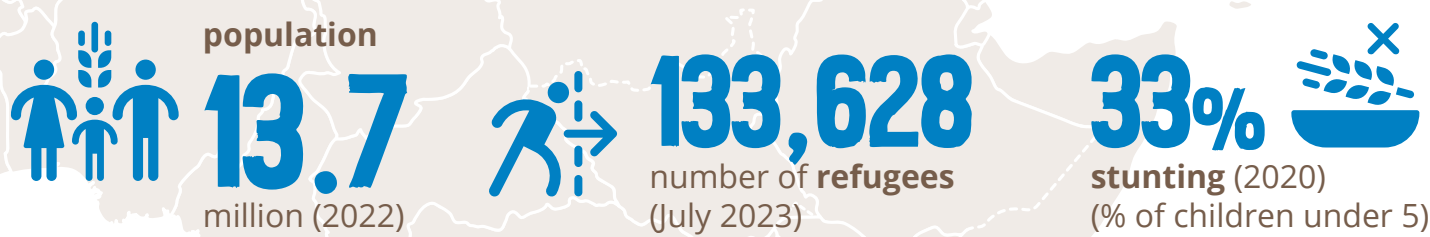
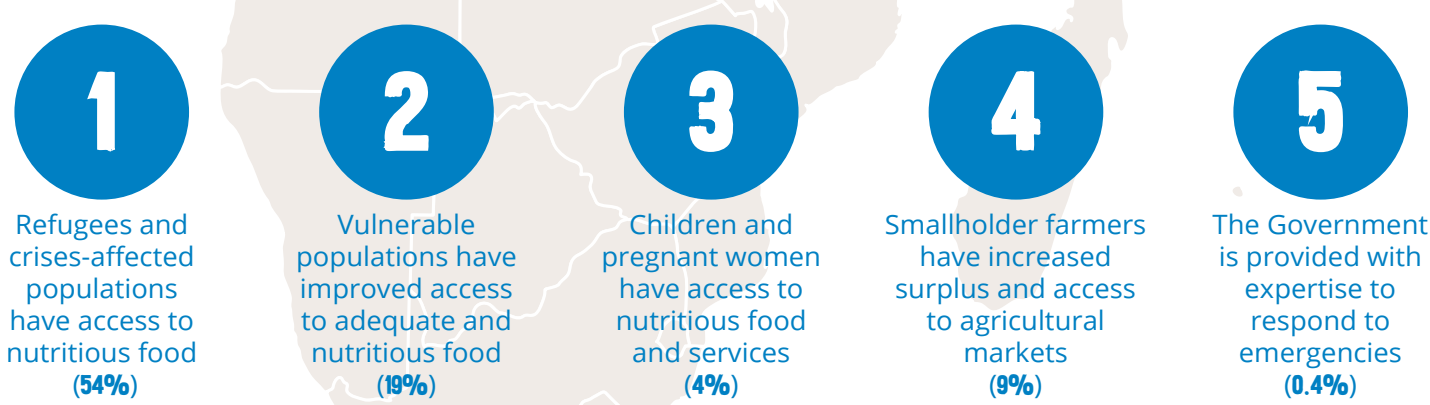

CSP RELEVANCE, COHERENCE AND STRATEGIC POSITIONING



Programmatic decisions, informed by food security data, meant CSP continued to be relevant

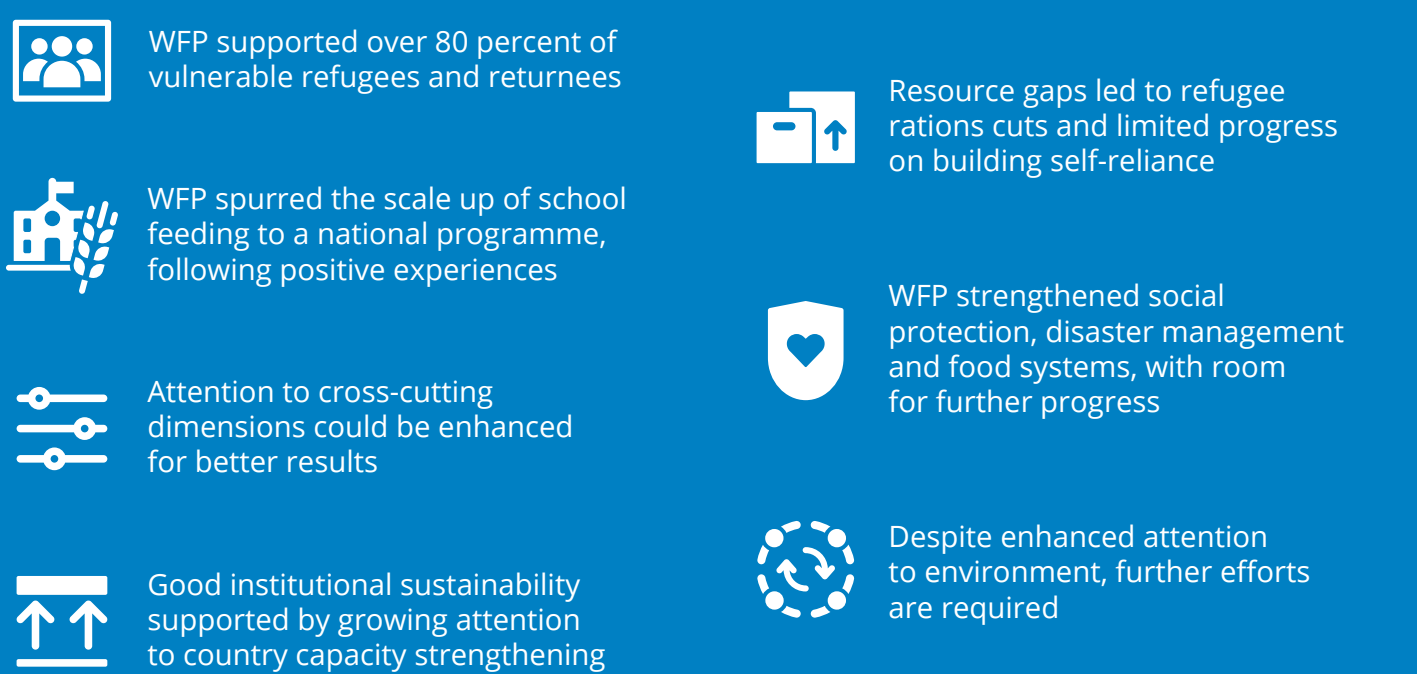


WFP well positioned across the development-humanitarian nexus with growing enabler role and support to recurrent shocks



Clear and integrated programme logic and expanded partnerships served coherence

CSP RESULTS



EFFICIENCY AND PERFORMANCE FACTORS



WFP delivery was timely, with high performing supply chains



WFP targeting was evidence-based and generally effective but constrained by a lack of data



Shift to cash, cascade trainings and good use of partnerships improved efficiency



Lack of donor diversity and heavy earmarking strongly affected CSP funding and performance

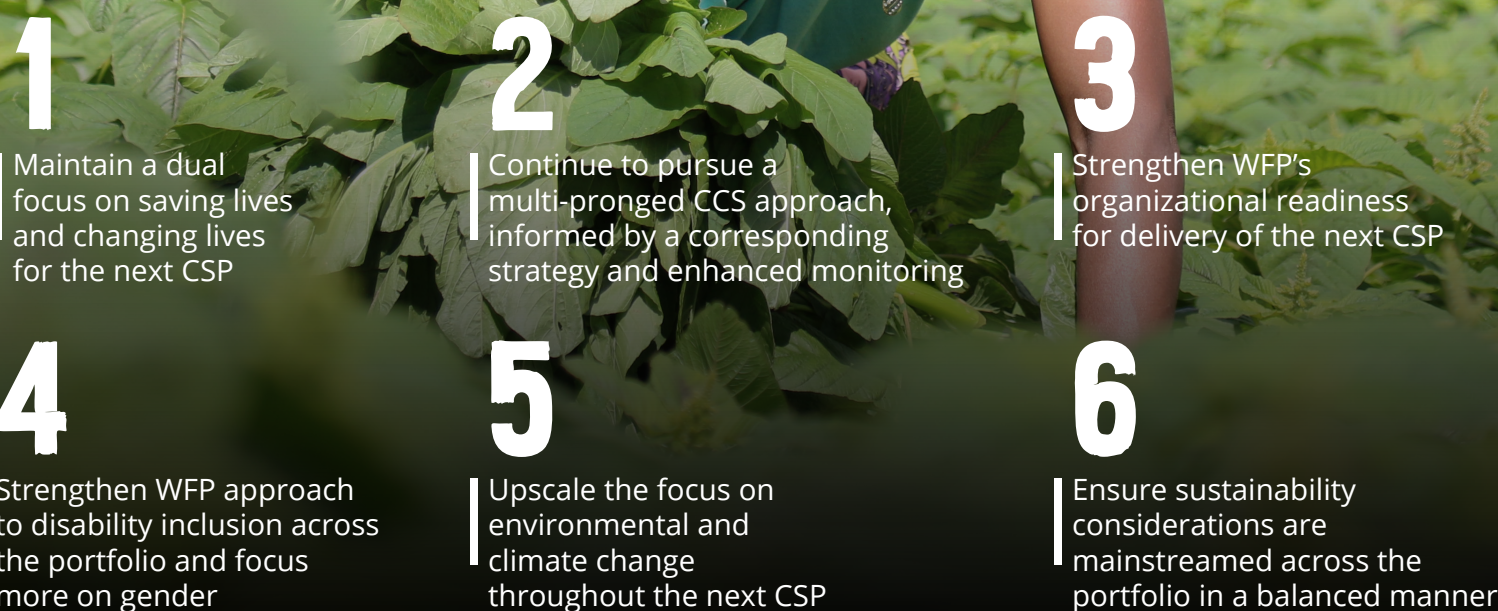


Weaknesses in M&E failed to support programme improvement
