WFP responsive to national priorities in migration management Transition to development-oriented interventions lacked strategic approach and integration in national systems



WFP was responsive to major shocks and evolving needs

EFFECTIVENESS AND SUSTAINABILITY



Effective large-scale emergency response benefitting refugees and earthquake-affected populations



Individual benefits of livelihood interventions but little sustainability at scale



Notable progress made on disability inclusion and gender equality

RESOURCING AND EFFICIENCY



advance financing to sustain emergency programming



cost per beneficiary created efficiency challenges for livelihood programming

FACTORS AFFECTING WFP PROGRAMMING



delivery and handover of emergency social safety net and earthquake response



inconsistent coordination with national structures constrained effectiveness



planning led to skill mismatch and reduced programme effectiveness



RECOMMENDATIONS & LESSONS LEARNED



Türkiye under a low-funding context, considering WFP's recognized global comparative advantages

LESSONS Integrating

Develop a strategic framework for support to community resilience in alignment with national priorities

Support the government's efforts to enhance emergencyy preparedness and response capacities, particularly at subnational level

LEARNED

humanitarian aid into national social protection boosts scale, efficiency, and sustainability

Cash transfers work better when tailored to specific needs (e.g. women, persons with disabilities)

-or broader results in a middle-income context, a stronger integration in government-led processes is essential

Flexible overhead rates may make WFP more competitive to secure funding in development-focused

settings
