### **COUNTRY CONTEXT**



population



collectively ranked out of 127 countries 2024 GHI scores

moved from lower-middle income status in 2001 to upper-middle income in 2010

population undernourished

children under 5 years old



**poverty rates** in rural areas were three times higher than those in urban areas

≈ 24.7% of population is estimated to be living on less than **\$6.85** per day

# COUNTRY STRATEGIC PLAN (CSP) focused on three strategic outcomes



Provide advice and assistance on integrating smallholder farmers into nutrition-sensitive value chain to national stakeholders (45%)



Provide advice and assistance on extending nutrition-sensitive school feeding programmes to national stakeholders (41%)



Provide facilitation for development and humanitarian cooperation with China (14%)

**SO1:** Left-behind groups in rural areas of China have improved nutritional status and livelihoods in line with national targets by 2025



**CSP budget** 15 USD million | 59% funded




