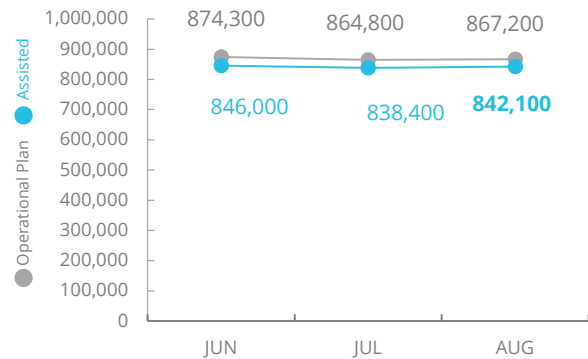


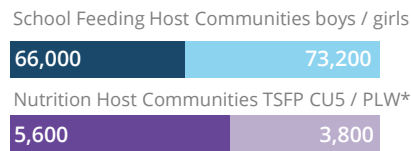
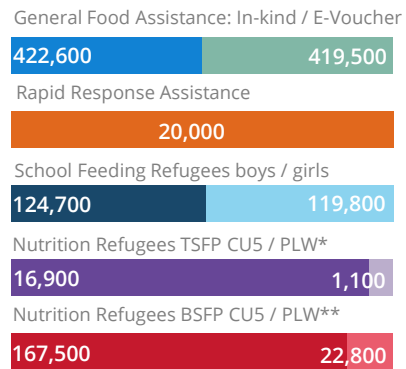

2019 LEVEL 2 RESPONSE: PHASE II (Sep – February 2020)

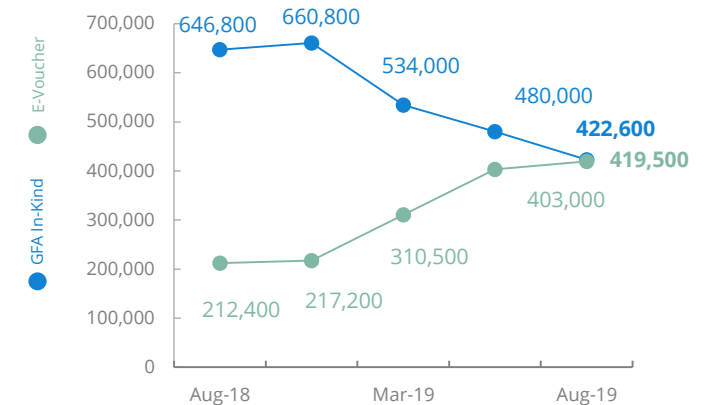
94% Contributions: US\$269m

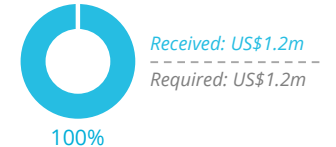

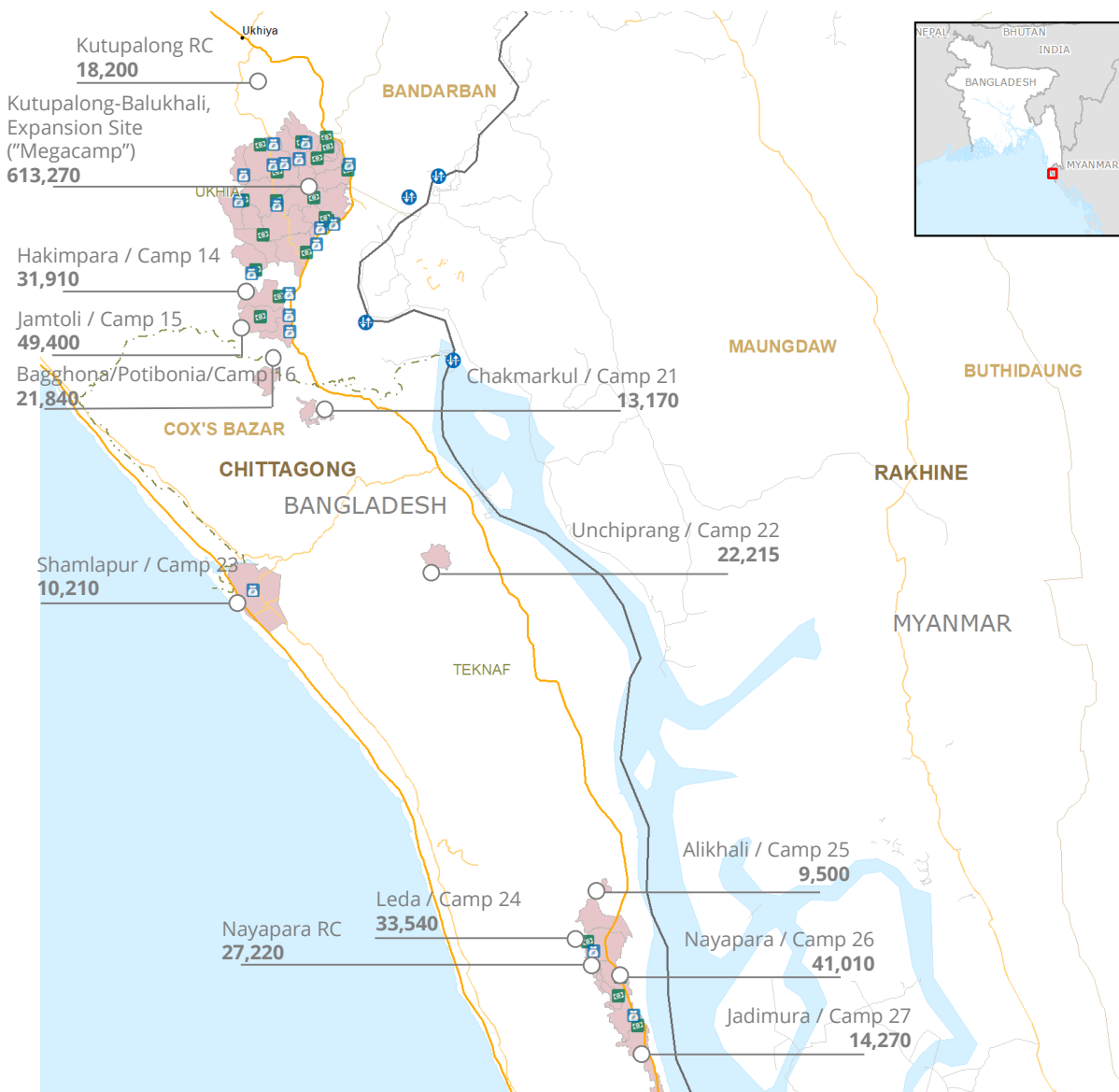
