WFP defines impact evaluation as:

EvaluationEvaluations that "assess the positive and negative, direct orPolicyindirect, intended or unintended changes in the lives of(2016-2021)affected populations in receipt of WFP interventions"

Impact Evaluation Strategy

Evaluations that "measure **changes** in development **outcomes of interest** for a target population that can be **attributed** to a specific programme or a policy through a **credible counterfactual**"
