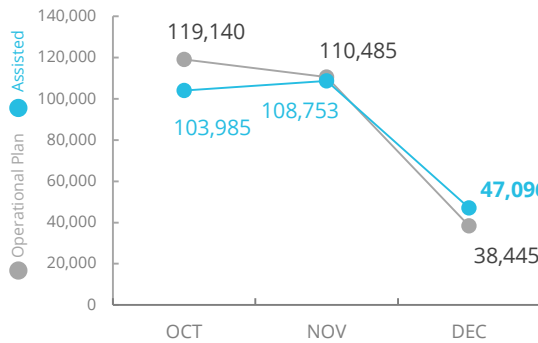

Libya Interim Country Strategic Plan (ICSP)

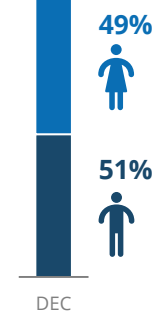

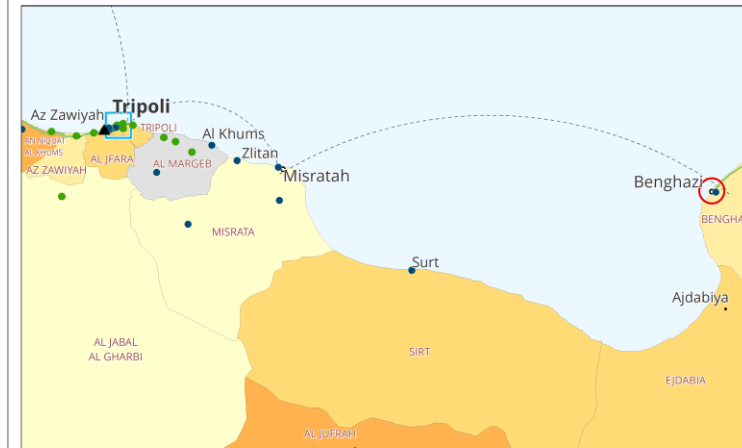

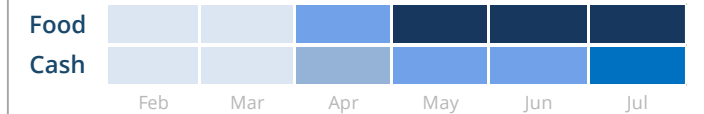
## RAPID RESPONSE MECHANISM LOCATIONS



## AVERAGE MONTHLY FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

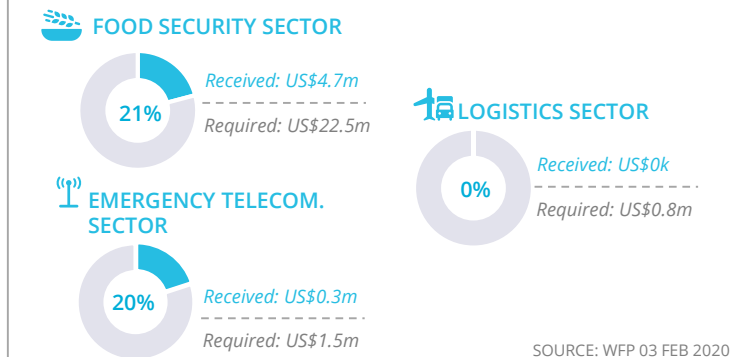

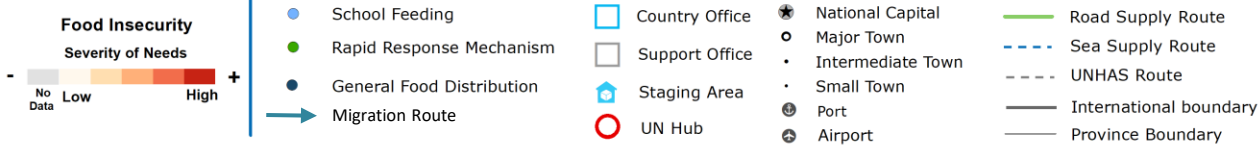
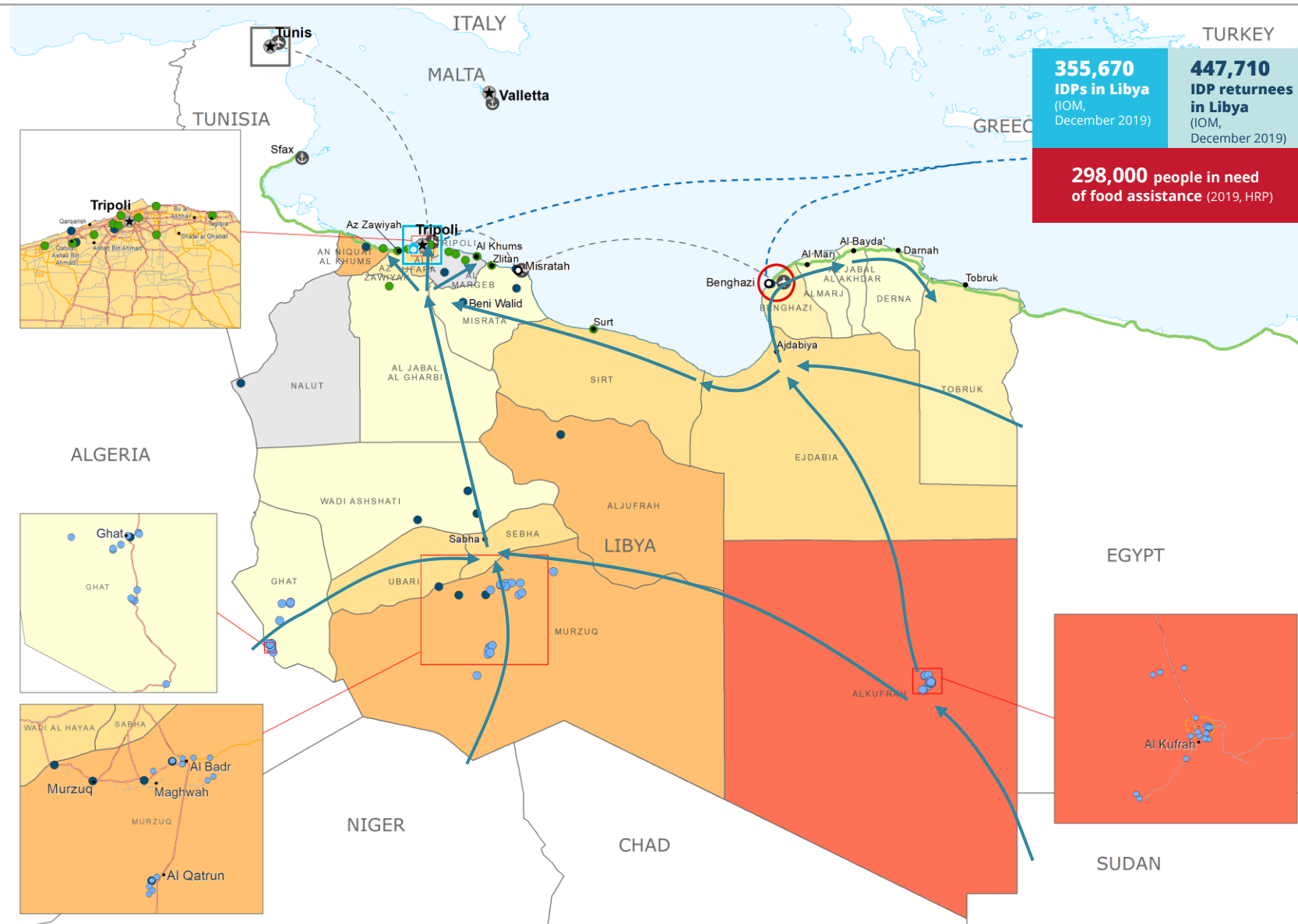
