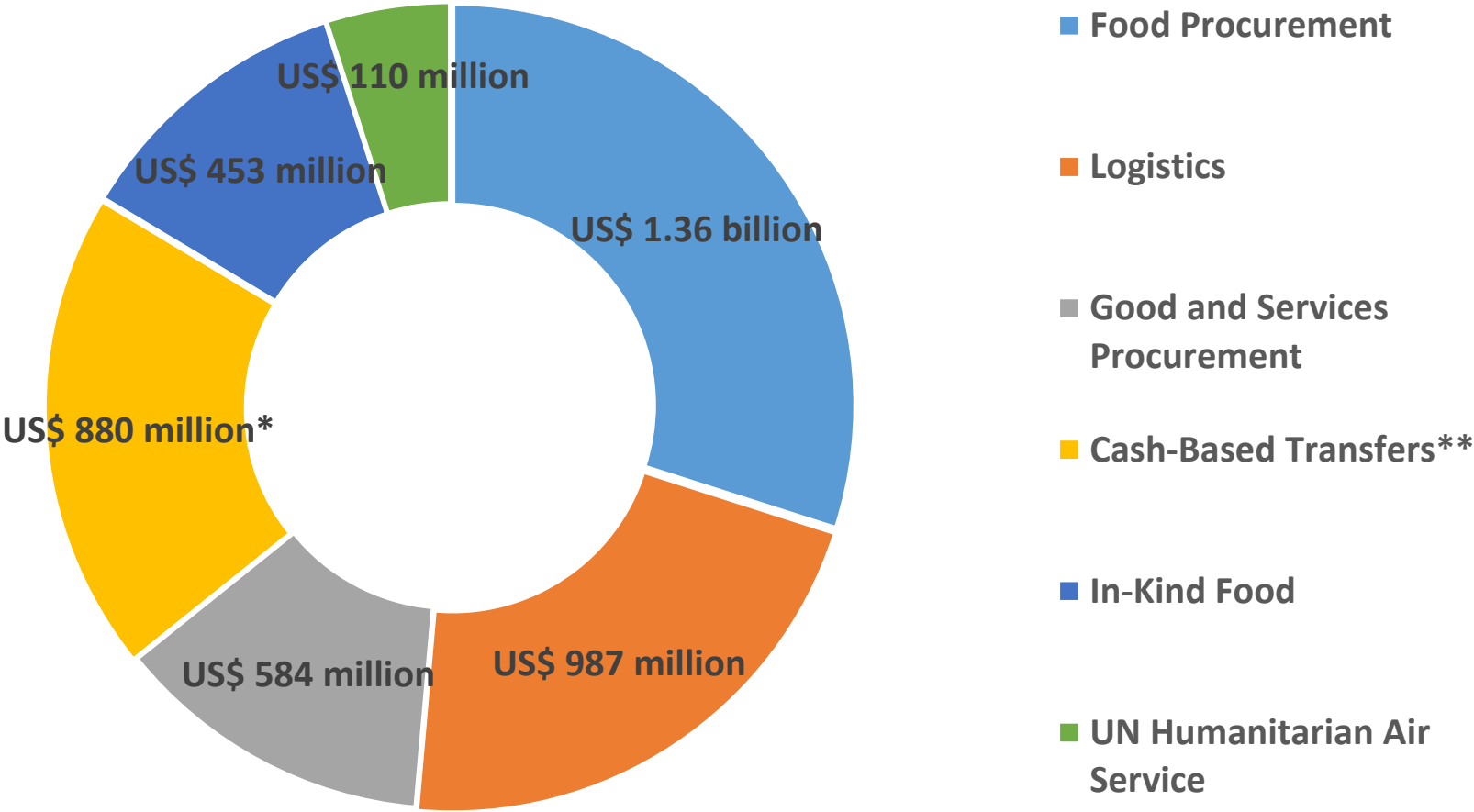

- Supported **UNDP/MoH** (PR of the **Global Fund**) to distribute national mosquito nets in Cambodia, DRC, Chad and Zambia



Taking over HIV Supply Chain in CAR

- Global Fund** extraordinarily requested WFP to lead supply chain activities for HIV/AIDS, TB and Malaria in CAR, with potential to expand to other 24 COE countries.

- Three year partnership (2017-2020) with the **Gates Foundation** to improve on-the-shelf availability of health commodities in 16 countries across Africa and South Asia
