

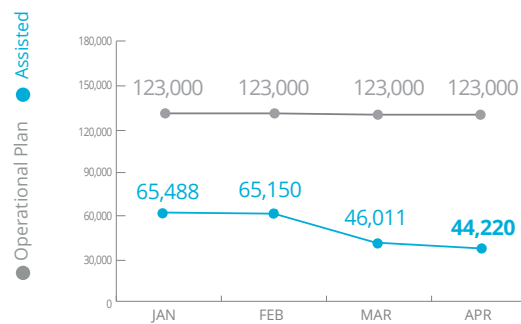

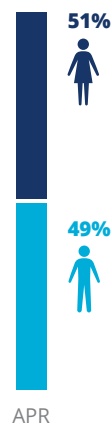

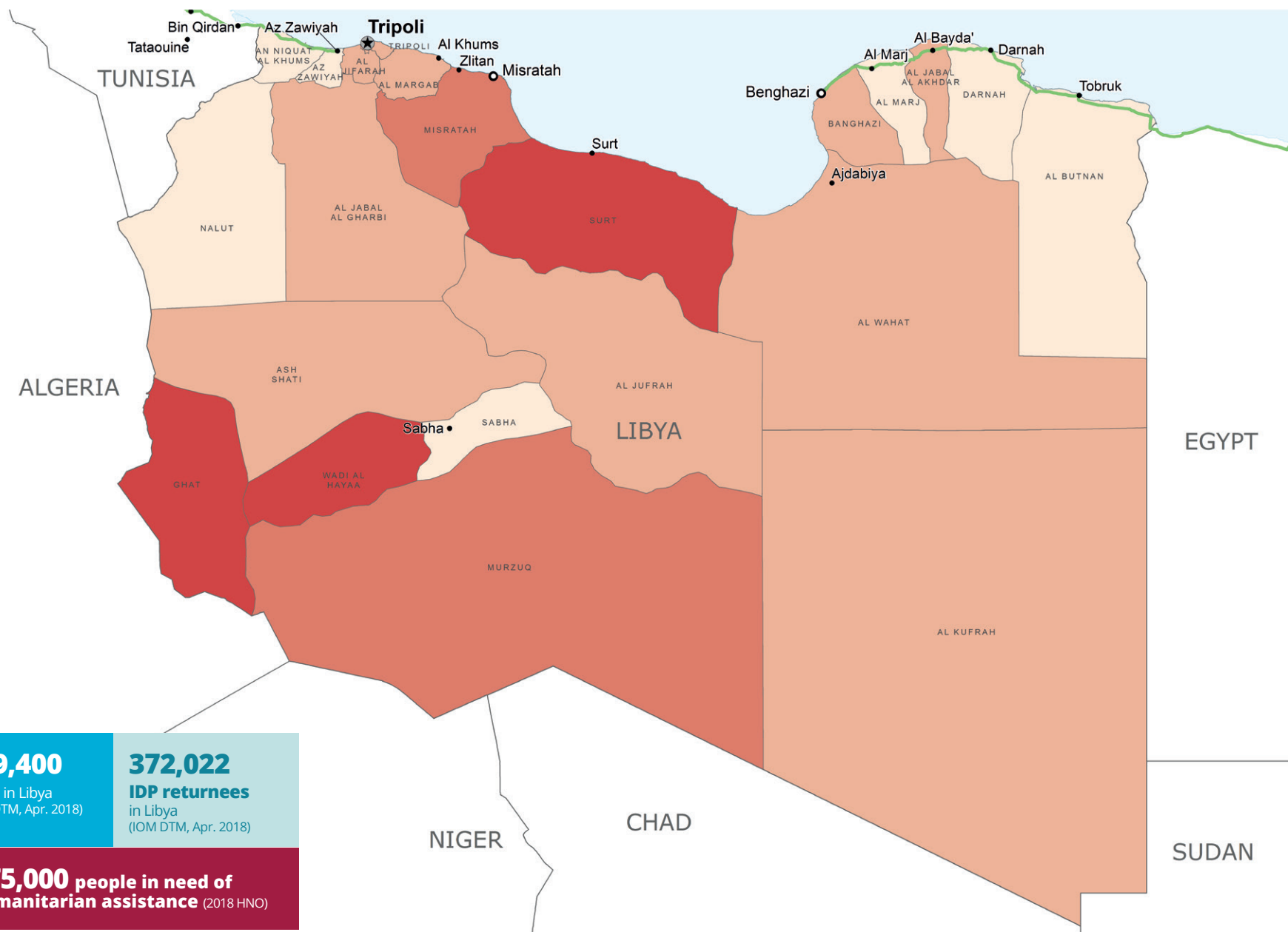

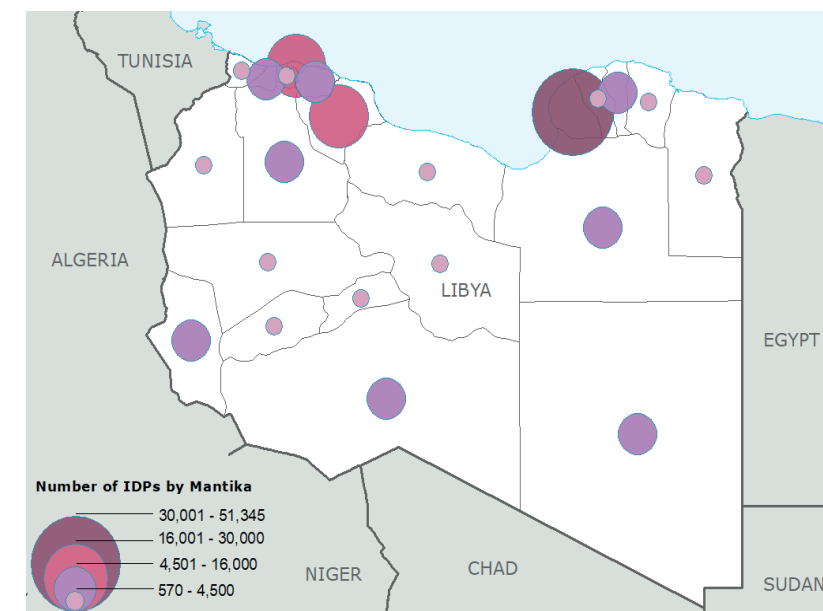


179,400 IDPs in Libya (IOM DTM, Apr. 2018)

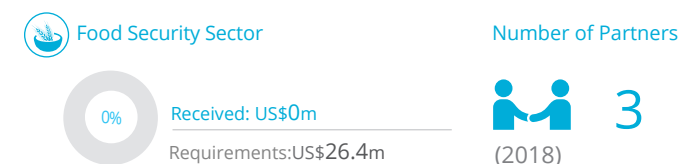
