

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








Support mechanisms for decentralized evaluation





Percentage of active policies approved since 2011 evaluated/under evaluation









Country Portfolio Evaluation coverage


Evaluation coverage of Corporate Emergency Responses

Country Programme Evaluation coverage


Percentage of country programmes that ended in 2017 that had a final evaluation in 2016 or 2017





Decentralized evaluation coverage


Percentage of country offices that have completed at least one decentralized evaluation in 2016 or 2017

Post-hoc quality assessment of evaluation reports completed, 2016–2017









Implementation of the 2017 OEV work plan (planned versus actual)






