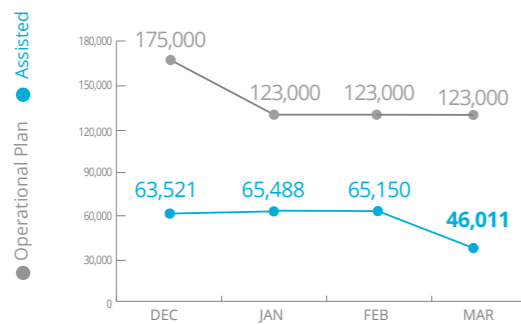

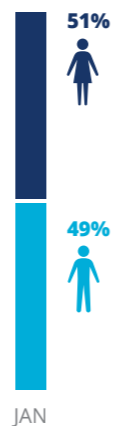

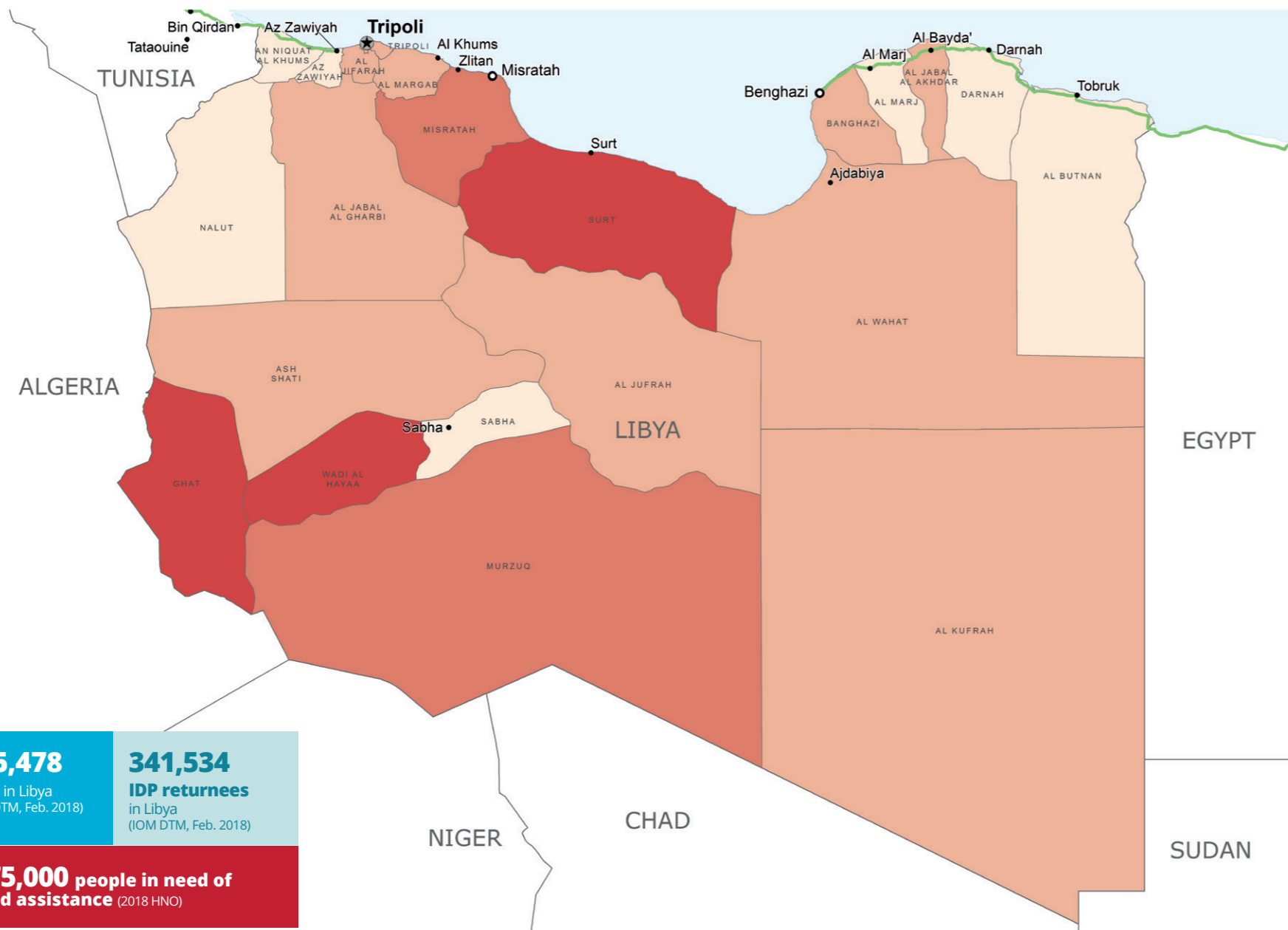

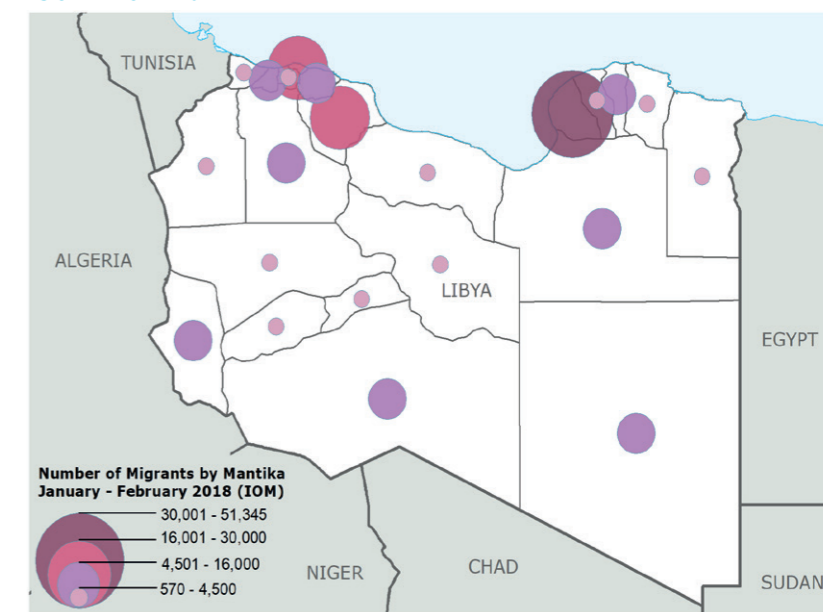

IDP CONCENTRATION

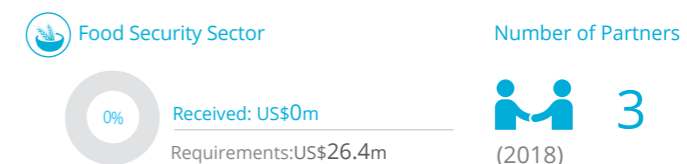

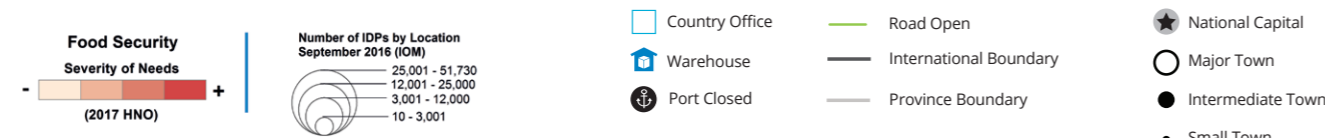
