

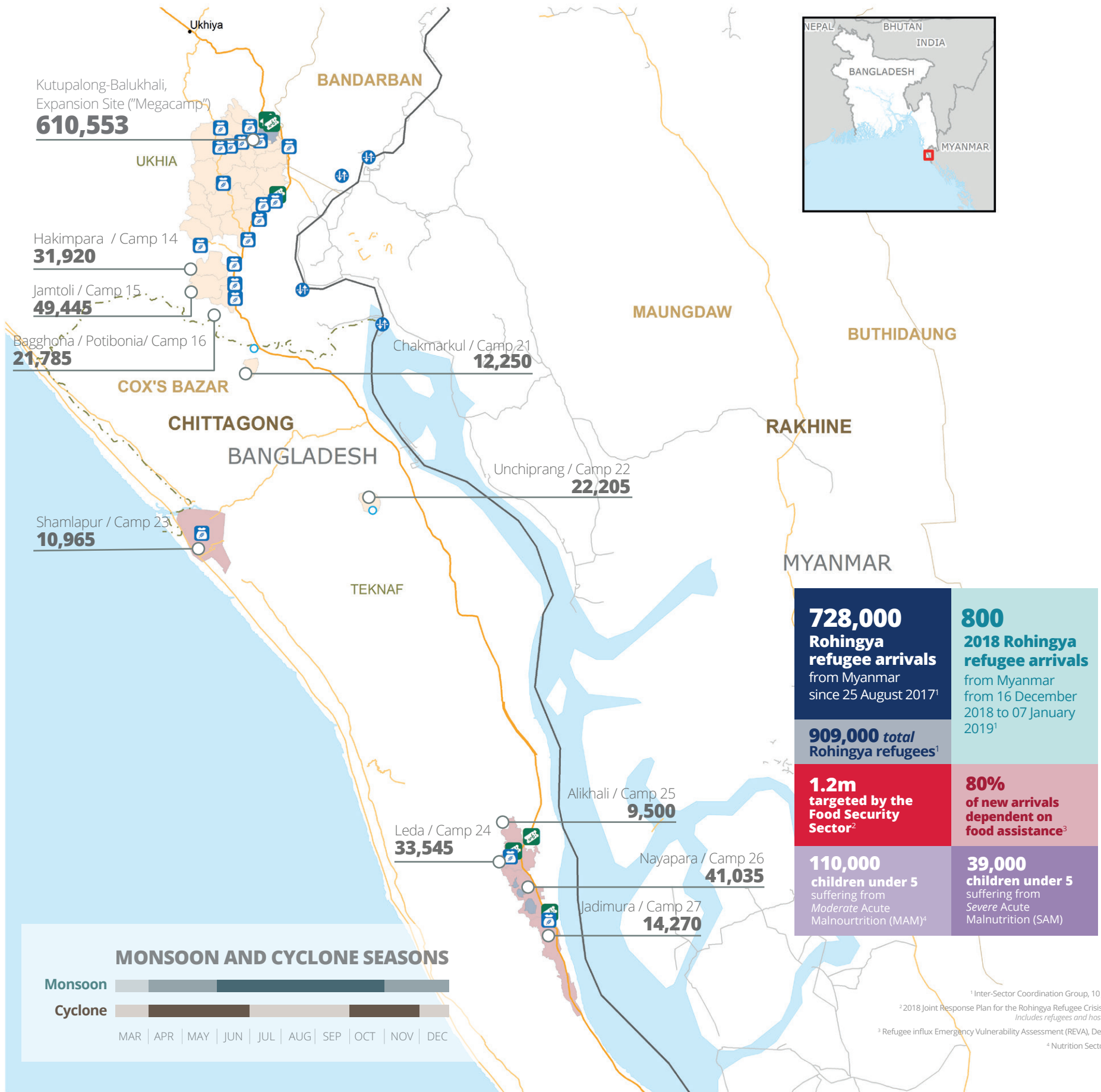

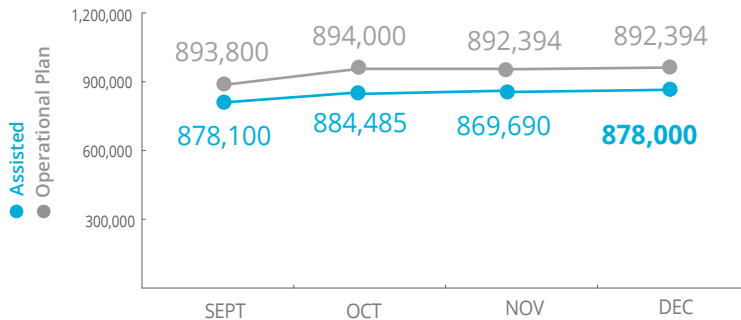

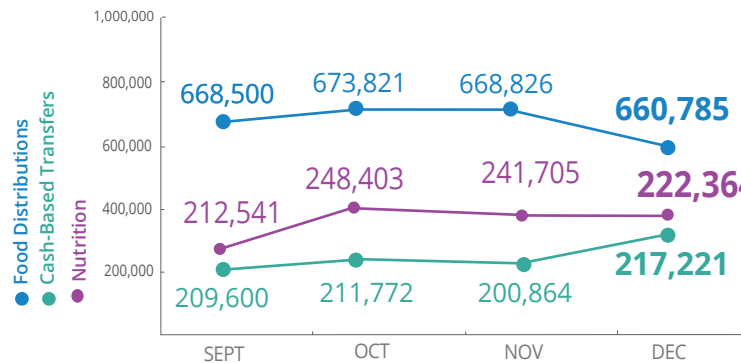


* The number of people targeted and reached has increased in September due to a new counting methodology for GFD beneficiaries

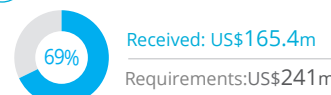

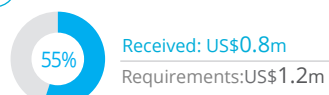
WFP-LED AND SUPPORTED SECTORS



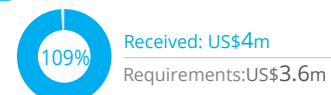
Food Security Sector



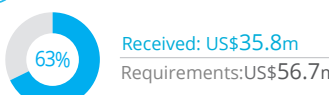
Emergency Telecommunications Sector
