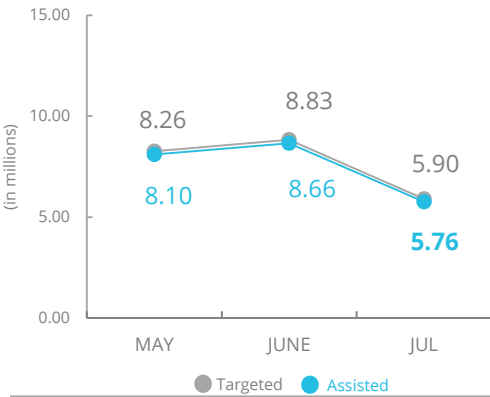


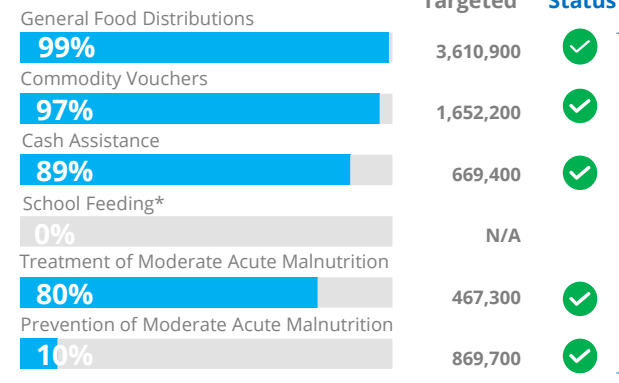

By Activity (July)



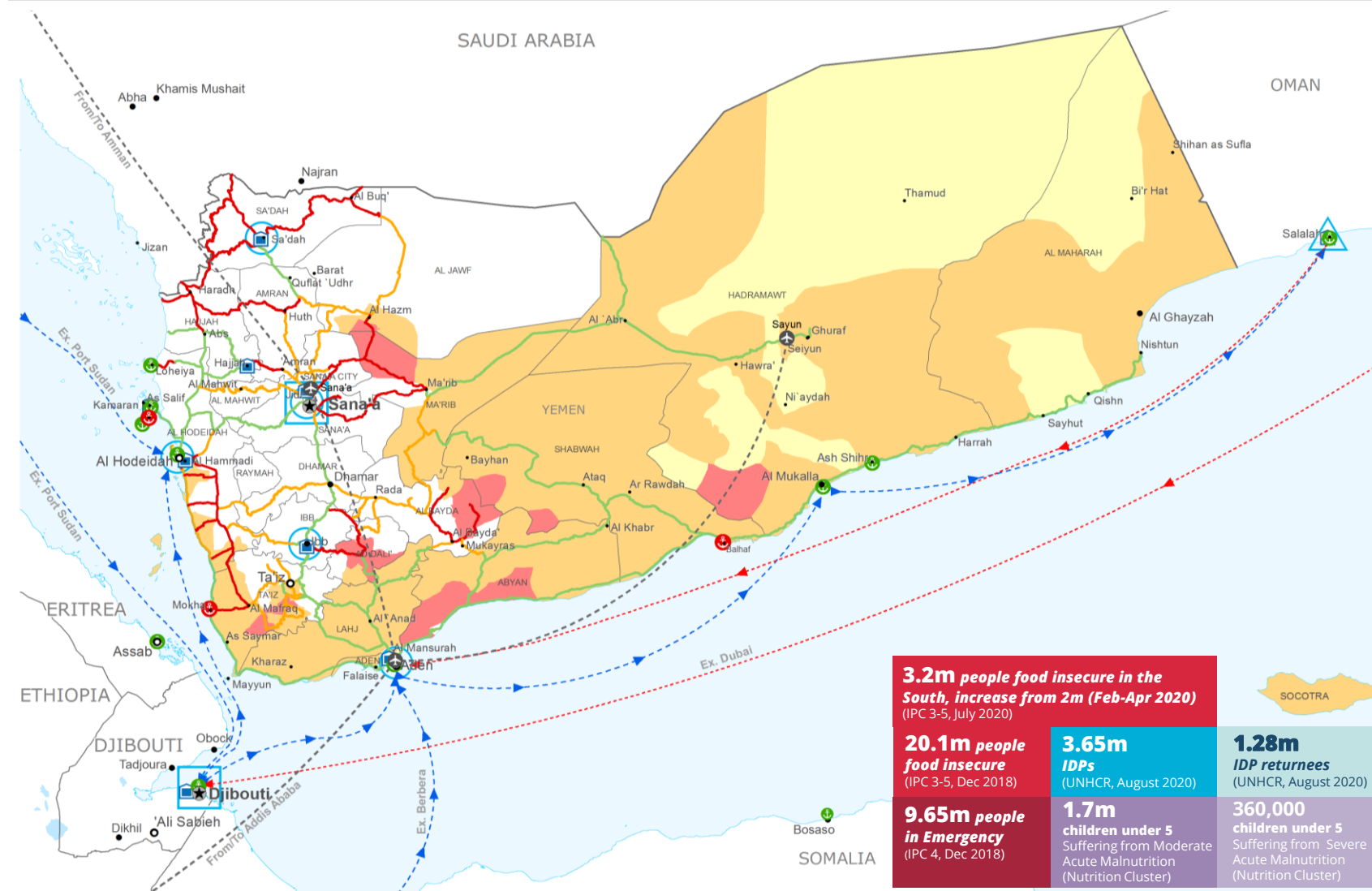

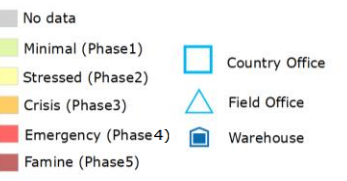

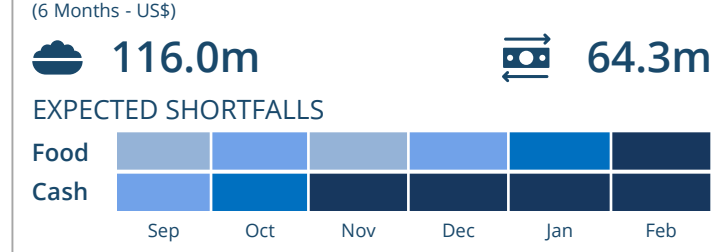

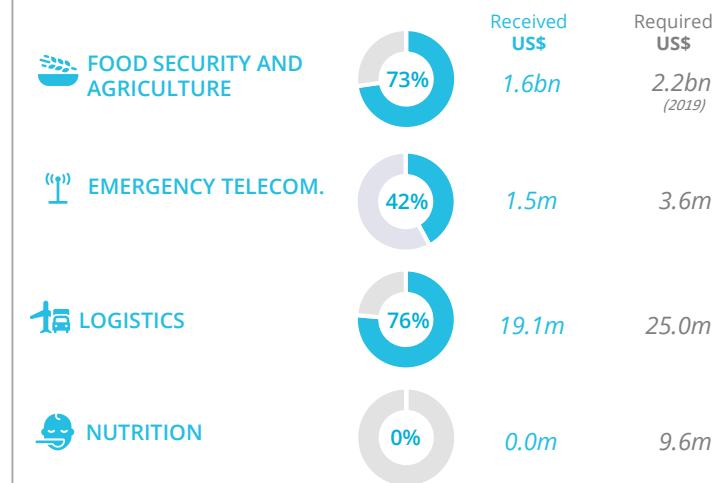


AVERAGE MONTHLY FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

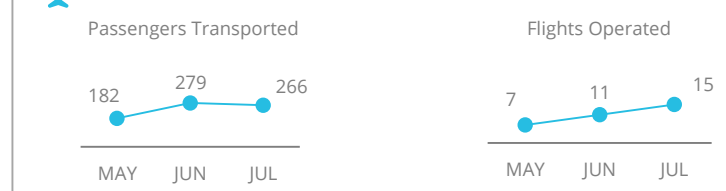
(6 Months - US\$)
